Scriptures – All Scriptures New Living Translation

2 Kings 4:1-2

One day the widow of a member of the group of prophets came to Elisha and cried out, "My husband who served you is dead, and you know how he feared the LORD. But now a creditor has come, threatening to take my two sons as slaves."

² "What can I do to help you?" Elisha asked. "Tell me, what do you have in the house?"

"Nothing at all, except a flask of olive oil," she replied.

2 Kings 4:8-14

⁸ One day Elisha went to the town of Shunem. A wealthy woman lived there, and she urged him to come to her home for a meal. After that, whenever he passed that way, he would stop there for something to eat.

⁹ She said to her husband, "I am sure this man who stops in from time to time is a holy man of God. ¹⁰ Let's build a small room for him on the roof and furnish it with a bed, a table, a chair, and a lamp. Then he will have a place to stay whenever he comes by."

¹¹ One day Elisha returned to Shunem, and he went up to this upper room to rest. ¹² He said to his servant Gehazi, "Tell the woman from Shunem I want to speak to her." When she appeared, ¹³ Elisha said to Gehazi, "Tell her, 'We appreciate the kind concern you have shown us. What can we do for you? Can we put in a good word for you to the king or to the commander of the army?" "

"No," she replied, "my family takes good care of me."

¹⁴ Later Elisha asked Gehazi, "What can we do for her?"

Gehazi replied, "She doesn't have a son, and her husband is an old man."

2 Kings 4:42-44

⁴² One day a man from Baal-shalishah brought the man of God a sack of fresh grain and twenty loaves of barley bread made from the first grain of his harvest. Elisha said, "Give it to the people so they can eat."

⁴³ "What?" his servant exclaimed. "Feed a hundred people with only this?"

But Elisha repeated, "Give it to the people so they can eat, for this is what the LORD says: Everyone will eat, and there will even be some left over!" ⁴⁴ And when they gave it to the people, there was plenty for all and some left over, just as the LORD had promised.

Whatever you're doing, make room for others!

- When you Make Room for God in your life, it will always mean making room for other people.
 - o Adam made room for Eve.
 - Abraham and Sarah made room for Isaac.
 - Moses made room for Joshua.
 - Elijah made room for Elisha.
 - o Elisha made room for 100 prophets.
 - o Jesus made room for His church... you and me.

It happened "one day". God will always do something when we are watching for Him to move.

Main Points:

- 1. Succession & Progression: Whatever you're doing, do as unto the Lord.
 - a. Set it up to succeed and proceed for a longtime.
 - i. This is a Kingdom virtue.
- 2. Less is More: Less of you, is more of others.
 - a. *Promotion* means you must decrease so others can increase.
- 3. God & the Devil Send People: When God wants to bless you, He sends a person. When the devil wants to hurt you, he sends a person.
 - a. Faithfulness and loyalty tell it all!
- 4. More People Means More Equipping & Training.
 - a. Ephesians 4:11-16
 - b. Find out who those people are... your kids, your friends, your business associates and church colleagues.
 - c. This is the heart of the Lord.

Faithfulness and loyalty are true marks of people sent by God to encourage you.
