Interpretation

- Why is God always the biggest thing in your life, no matter what is going on in your life?
- What does it mean to have "synergy" with God?
- How do we become co-laborer's with God in the "saving of souls"?

Application

- How do you "brag" on Jesus?
- Are there things in your life you need to surrender to God, in order to allow Him to be the biggest thing in your life?
- How are you working together with God?
