- What did you hear?

**Digging Deeper:**

*Revelation*

- What does it mean to know and understand that God is “reliable”?
- What does it mean that “Jesus is the Author” of our life? (Hebrews 12:2)
- What's the difference between allowing God to be the driver, or us as individuals to be the driver?

*God is the Author, which means He took the initiative in our lives.*

*Interpretation*

- When we say “I feel” I should be doing this, how are we moving away from allowing God to write the script?
- How do we allow Jesus to be the “Author” of our life?
- Why is it important to note that David “asked” the Lord, and didn't “tell” the Lord? (2 Samuel 5:17-25)

*Application*
