Digging Deeper:

Revelation

- How does Joseph's "Coat of Many Colours" represent "God's Wisdom"?
- What part of God's Colour Chart does Ephesians 4:11-12 represent?
 - o Why is it important to see all five of these colours working in the church and in society?

The Coat of Many Colours is not only associated with the Presence of God. but also with the Wisdom of God.

Interpretation

- What does it mean to have "manifold wisdom of God" according to Ephesians 3:10?
- How is the Presence of God released through His Colour Chart via the church?
- What is "The end time colour chart" according to God? (Revelation 7:9)

Application

- How are you experiencing God's Colour Chart in your life?
- Watch for God to give you a "new way" of doing what you've done before.
