Scriptures – All Scriptures New Living Translation

2 Kings 4:42-44

⁴² One day a man from Baal-shalishah brought the man of God a sack of fresh grain and twenty loaves of barley bread made from the first grain of his harvest. Elisha said, "Give it to the people so they can eat."

⁴³ "What?" his servant exclaimed. "Feed a hundred people with only this?"

But Elisha repeated, "Give it to the people so they can eat, for this is what the LORD says: Everyone will eat, and there will even be some left over!" ⁴⁴ And when they gave it to the people, there was plenty for all and some left over, just as the LORD had promised.

Introduction Notes:

- Up to this 4th story of Making Room for God, we've been talking about pots and pans, a new room in house and a big pot.
- Here we have a new way of making room for God... it's not a container. It's an action.

In our text for this message, we find a man who is generous with a first fruit, during a time of famine.

Main Points:

- 1. You Can Only Keep What You Give Away Vs. 42
 - a. To make more room for God, start giving away what you already have. Share it with other people.
- 2. Your Thinking Has to Change Vs. 43
 - a. The Servant said, "there's not enough for 100 people!"
 - b. Elisha said, "Give and you will have more than enough."
- 3. Miracles are Repeatable Vs. 44
 - a. John 6:5-13 There are two kinds of thinking.
 - b. Elisha to Jesus, to you and to me.

Digging Deeper:

Revelation

- How does giving something away, make room for God?
- What is the significance of giving a first fruit?
- How are miracles repeatable?
 - o 1 Kings 17
 - o John 6

It takes more faith to give a first fruit than a tithe.

Interpretation

- What's the significance of the name change from Shalishah to Baal-Shalishah?
- How do we know the servant doesn't understand what is about to take place?
- How do we transition from a mindset of not enough, to more than enough?
- Where do we see this miracle repeated? (John 6:5-13)

You have to use it – a gift – in order to see it grow.

Application

- What do you have that you can give away, in order to make room for God?
- Are there areas in your life where you need to change your thinking?
- Do you really believe in miracles?

You can have just a little, but when God is in it, what you have can be multiplied. Remember, little is much when God is in it.
