God is a God of Growth and He has a plan to help you grow.

There are seasons when you should listen to the voices, and there are seasons when you don't listen to the voices.

Main Points:

1. David – Samuel: Consecrated/Potential – 1 Samuel 16
 - a. Be diligent in what life gives you.
2. David – Goliath: Confrontation/Pressure – 1 Samuel 17
 - a. Stick to what you know.
3. David – Jonathan: Comfort/Peace – 1 Samuel 18
4. David – Saul: Conflict/Promotion – 1 Samuel 19-31
 - a. Turn the tables.
5. David – King: Crown/Purpose – 2 Samuel 2 & 5
 - a. Apply it.

When you're under pressure, do what you know what to do.

Digging Deeper:

Revelation

- What was the process of David from shepherd to King?
- What voices were speaking to David through his growth process?
- Why is it important to serve where God has placed you?

Interpretation

- How does David defeat Goliath?
- How does David grow into his place of Kingship?
- Why is it important to note that David said, *"I'm not familiar with this armor"* when facing Goliath?
 - How is this different from when Jonathan gave him his armor?

Application

- What voices are you listening to speaking into your life?
- What phase of life are you in as you grow in God toward your purpose and destiny?
 - Compare with main points of message listed above.
- When you're under pressure, do you know how to discern the voice of God?
- Have you discovered how God speaks to you?

The pressure that comes in life is often the place where you discover what God wants you to know in order to move into your purpose and destiny.
