It's time to “activate” our spiritual senses.

Scripture:

- 2 Corinthians 2:14-16

God want's our spiritual senses alive and revived through the power of the Holy Spirit!

Main Points

1. Recognize the Presence (Worship)
2. Detect Problems (Wickedness)
3. Be Pleasant (Witness)

A pleasing Presence of the Lord activates our spiritual senses.

Starter Questions:

- What did you hear?
 - What point in this message was most impactful for you?
- What do you think?
 - How did this message challenge, change or affirm your thinking?
- What will you do?
 - How will you put into practice what you've learned today?

As we surrender to Jesus, we become a pleasing aroma to God.

Digging Deeper:

Revelation

- What does it mean to be a “pleasing aroma” to God?
- Why does a “pleasing aroma to God” activate an “intimacy” with God?
- What blocks a “pleasing aroma” to God as seen in the Ephesians passages shared in this message?

Interpretation

- How can we be a “pleasing aroma” to God?
- How does “worship” release the presence of God in our midst?

Application

- Is your spirit alive and revived through the power of the Holy Spirit?
- Is your life a “pleasing aroma” to God?
- How are you carrying the “pleasing aroma” of God to others around you?

We are victorious and a pleasing aroma to God, because of the victory of Jesus on the Cross.
