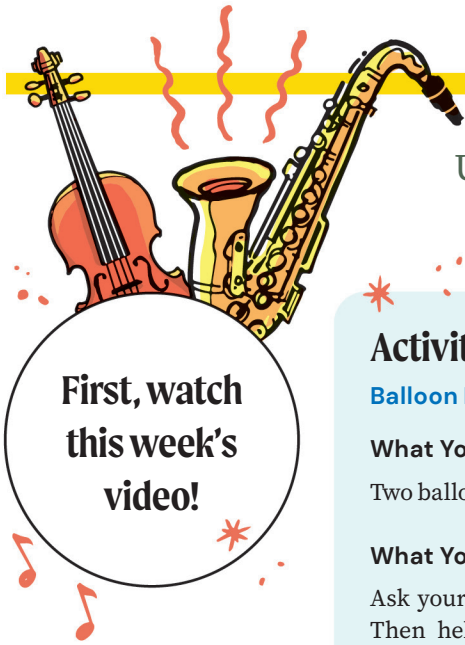


Jam Session: Everyone has a part to play

Activity

Balloon Bounce

What You Need:

Two balloons (or beach balls)

What You Do:

Ask your child to blow up the balloon. Then help them out by tying off the balloon, if needed. Take a few steps away from each other.

Next, take turns bouncing the balloon back and forth. See how many times you can bounce it between the two of you before it hits the ground. Play a few rounds, trying to break that record.

Then, increase the challenge by blowing up another balloon and tying it off. Now, try to keep both balloons off the ground. See how many times you can bounce the balloons back and forth by counting each time you hit the balloons out loud.

Bible Story

Jesus Heals a Man
Who Could Not
Walk / Four Friends
Luke 5:17-26

Key Question

Who do you know
who needs help?

Talk About the Bible Story

How did our balloon bouncing require us to cooperate?

In our story today, who worked together to help the man who couldn't walk? (*The man's friends*)

When the man was lowered in front of Jesus, Jesus saw his needs. How did Jesus help the man? (*Jesus saw that the man needed forgiveness, so He said, 'Your sins are forgiven.' Jesus also healed the man so he could walk. In both ways, Jesus gave the man what he needed.*)

Jesus worked together with the friends to help someone in need. Does Jesus work together with us today to help others? Why or why not?

Parent: Share about a time when you worked together with others to help someone in need.

Prayer

Use this prayer as a guide, either after talking about the Bible story or sometime before bed tonight:

"God, You are always there when we need You! This story shows us how important it is for us to work together to help others. The man in our story today had great friends! His friends supported him and worked together to bring him to Jesus for healing. There are so many people who need help. Please show us how we can work together to help others. God, thank You for seeing what we need, and for sending Jesus to make a way for us to be with You now and forever! Amen."
