Psalm 89:47a

O remember how short my time is and what a mere fleeting life mine is....

Psalm 90:12

Teach us to realize the brevity of life, so that we may grow in wisdom.

Psalm 102:3a

For my days vanish like smoke...

Psalm 144:4

Man is like a mere breath; His days are like a passing shadow.

James 4:14b

...For what is your life? You are just a vapor that appears for a little while and then vanishes away.

AMP: You are really but a wisp of vapor (a puff of smoke, a mist) that is visible for a little while and then disappears into thin air.

Job 14:1-2

1 Man who is born of a woman is few of days and full of trouble.

2 He comes out like a flower and withers; he flees like a shadow and continues not.

Psalm 39:4-5

4 LORD, remind me how brief my time on earth will be. Remind me that my days are numbered— how fleeting my life is.

5 You have made my life no longer than the width of my hand. My entire lifetime is just a moment to you; at best, each of us is but a breath.

Isaiah 40:6-8

6 A voice said, “Shout!” I asked, “What should I shout?” “Shout that people are like the grass. Their beauty fades as quickly as the flowers in a field.

7 The grass withers and the flowers fade beneath the breath of the LORD. And so it is with people.

8 The grass withers and the flowers fade, but the word of our God stands forever.”

Ephesians 5:15-17

15 See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise,

16 Redeeming the time because the days are evil

AMP:

15 Look carefully then how you walk! Live purposefully and worthily and accurately, not as the unwise and witless, but as wise (sensible people),

16 Making the very most of the time [buying up each opportunity], because the days are evil.

17 Therefore do not be vague and thoughtless and foolish, but understanding and firmly grasping what the will of the Lord is.
