THE FIRST STEP TOWARDS DILIGENCE:

RECOGNIZE THAT APATHY LEADS TO DESTITUTION

So how long are you going to laze around doing nothing? How long before you get out of bed? A nap here, a nap there, a day off here, a day off there, sit back, take it easy—do you know what comes next? Just this: You can look forward to a dirt-poor life, poverty your permanent houseguest! — Proverbs 6:9-11 (MSG)

Diligence: a persistent and earnest application to an undertaking, giving steady effort and attentive care, knowing it will serve others in some beneficial way.

THE FOUR WHEELS OF DILIGENCE

1. STEADY APPLICATION

Easy come, easy go, but steady diligence pays off. – Proverbs 13:11 (MSG)

An inheritance quickly gained at the beginning will not be blessed at the end. – Proverbs 20:21 (NIV)

1 Thessalonians 4:11; 2 Thessalonians 3:6-12

2. READY ACTION

May the God who has chosen the city of Jerusalem as the place to honor his name destroy any king or nation that violates this command and destroys this Temple. "I, Darius, have issued this decree. Let it be obeyed with all diligence." – Ezra 6:12 (NLT)

Preach the Word; be ready (KJV – instant) in season and out of season. – 2 Timothy 4:2 (ESV)

3. FOCUSED ARTISTRY

Idle hands make one poor, but diligent hands bring riches. – Proverbs 10:4 (HCSB)

For we are God's masterpiece, he has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago. – Ephesians 2:10 (NLT)

Everything that the God of Heaven has required should be precisely done for the temple of the God of Heaven. Why should there be wrath against the empire of the king...? – Ezra 7:23 (NET)

4. ATTENTIVE CARE

Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it. – Genesis 1:28 (KJV)
