Through Knowing God is in Control

Against its will, all creation was subjected to God's curse. FOUR KEYS TO CONQUER BITTERNESS

1. The Holy Spirit is Praying for Me.

In the same way the Spirit also comes to help us, weak as we are. For we do not know how we ought to pray; the Spirit himself pleads with God for us in groans that words cannot express. - Romans 8:26 GNT

2. God is Using Everything for My Good.

And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. - Romans 8:28 NIV

3. God Wants Me to Succeed.

What shall we say about such wonderful things as these? If God is for us, who can ever be against us? - Romans 8:31 NLT

4. God Will Give Me What I Need.

Since he did not spare even his own Son but gave him up for us all, won't he also give us everything else? - Romans 8:32 NLT

7. Overcoming Insecurity

Through Securing My Heart in God's Love

And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. ³⁹ No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.
