2. The Look Up: Thanksgiving



For I pass on to you what I received from the Lord himself. On the night when he was betrayed, the Lord Jesus took some bread and gave thanks to God for it.

3. The Look Back: Remembrance



Then he broke it in pieces and said, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."...

1 Corinthians 11:24-25 NLT

... In the same way, he took the cup of wine after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant between God and his people an agreement confirmed with my blood. Do this in remembrance of me as often as you drink it." **1 Corinthians 11:24-25 NLT**





4. The Look Forward: Proclamation



For every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are announcing the Lord's death until he comes again.

1 Corinthians 11:26 NLT

And he took a cup of wine and gave thanks to God for it. He gave it to them and said, "Each of you drink from it, for this is my blood, which confirms the covenant between God and his people... Matthew 26:27-29 NLT

... It is poured out as a sacrifice to forgive the sins of many. Mark my words—I will not drink wine again until the day I drink it new with you in my Father's Kingdom."



Then I heard again what sounded like the shout of a vast crowd or the roar of mighty ocean waves or the crash of loud thunder...

... "Praise the Lord! For the Lord our God, the Almighty, reigns. Let us be glad and rejoice and let us give honor to him. For the time has come for the wedding feast of the Lamb, and his bride has prepared herself...

... She has been given the finest of pure white linen to wear." For the fine linen represents the good deeds of God's holy people...

...And the angel said to me, "Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the wedding feast of the Lamb." And he added, "These are true words that come from God."





So anyone who eats this bread or drinks this cup of the Lord unworthily is guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. That is why you should examine yourself before eating the bread and drinking the cup...

1 Corinthians 11:27-30 NLT

... For if you eat the bread or drink the cup without honoring the body of Christ, you are eating and drinking God's judgment upon yourself. That is why many of you are weak and sick and some have even died. **1 Corinthians 11:27-30 NLT**

When we were utterly helpless, Christ came at just the right time and died for us sinners. Now, most people would not be willing to die for an upright person, though someone might perhaps be willing to die for a person who is especially good ... Romans 5:6-11 NLT

...But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners. And since we have been made right in God's sight by the blood of Christ, he will certainly save us from God's condemnation...
