## **Closer to My Purpose**

## **How to Grow Closer to My Purpose**

### 1. **CONTEMPLATE** God's Glory.

One thing I ask from the LORD, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the LORD and to seek him in his temple. - Psalm 27:4 NIV

We Go to Scripture Not Just for Light...but also for HEAT.

#### 2. Walk in **HUMILITY**.

Then I said, "It's all over! I am doomed, for I am a sinful man. I have filthy lips, and I live among a people with filthy lips. Yet I have seen the King, the LORD of Heaven's Armies." - Isaiah 6:5 NLT

All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, "God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble." - 1 Peter 5:5b NIV

# God Doesn't Exist for us, We Exist for Him and to Bring Him Glory.

We are to Be Like a WEDDING Planner.

For my own sake, for my own sake, I do this. How can I let myself be defamed? I will not yield my glory to another. - Isaiah 48:11 NIV

#### 3. Serve With **BOLDNESS**.

Therefore, since we have such a hope, we are very bold. - 2 Corinthians 3:12 NIV

  - c. How is this the basis for Paul's hope and boldness?
  - d. What are the practical results of this new covenant (see verses 16-18)?
- 3. Which verse in the outline above spoke most to you in this message? Share with us why you chose that verse.
- 4. Of the three points under, *How To Grow Closer To My Purpose*, which one stood out to you? Explain.
- 5. What is the most practical thing you can do this week to "reflect the Lord's glory"?
- 6. Have a time of prayer for each other to really shine for Jesus Christ in the marketplaces of life.
