Every 30 seconds an abortion takes place in America!

24% of women will have an abortion by age 45 in America.

Abortion is devastating the minority communities, especially the black community, where 28% of all black women who are pregnant have an abortion!

In 2015 approximately 35% of **ALL PREGNANCIES** in New York City ended in abortion. (CDC)

In 2014 approximately 19% or 1/5th of **ALL USA PREGNANCIES** ended in abortion!

58% of all abortions in 2015 were from women in their 20's.

40% of minors, having an abortion, report that neither of their parents knew about the abortion.

70% of women who have had an abortion indicate their religious preference is Christian.

61% of women seeking an abortion felt they would receive judgement and condemnation from the church if they told them!

65% of women who have had an abortion agree that the church members judge single women who are pregnant!

64% agree that church members are more likely to gossip about a woman considering abortion than help her understand options.

While a father or a medical professional would most likely be consulted by a woman before an abortion (father 61%, medical 48%), a local church and a pregnancy center tied at 7%!

76% said their local church had no influence on their decision to terminate their pregnancy!

43% of woman say it is safe to talk with their pastor about an abortion that has already taken place.

49% say that too often forgiveness for abortion doesn't seem to be included in a pastor's teaching on forgiveness!
