Promises, Promises



“All Of God’s Promises Are True!”



“... for God can be trusted to keep his promise.” - Hebrews 10:23

SAY:

We live in a world full of empty promises. People say one thing and do another. Companies advertise for one thing, and what you get is something else. Even the people we love fail us sometimes.

In a world in which promises often turn out to be merely words, it has become very difficult to trust anyone. That’s what happened to Abraham and Sarah. When they found out God promised them they would have a baby, it sounded too good to be true, but they found out soon that what God promises, He will do.

READ:

Genesis 17:1-8; Genesis 18:1-15; Genesis 21:1-7

ASK/DISCUSS:

- How old was Abraham when God promised Him he would have a son?
- How old was Sarah?
- Where was Abraham working when three important men came by?
- What did one of the men at the lunch tell Abraham? Who overheard?
- Did God fulfill His promise to Abraham and Sarah?

SAY:

God isn’t like us humans - God cannot lie. God ALWAYS tells the truth, and that means we can trust His promises, no matter what!

PRAY:

Pray for your children to trust God no matter what. Pray they would trust God’s Word and be able to stand on His promises throughout their lives.
