"LOST" IMPLIES VALUE

JESUS CAME TO...

I. HEAL THOSE WHO HAVE LOST THEIR HEALTH.

"Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people. News about him spread all over Syria, and people brought to him all who were ill with various diseases, those suffering severe pain, the demonpossessed, those having seizures, and the paralyzed; and he healed them." Matthew 4:23-24 (NIV)

THE HEALING OF A MAN WITH LEPROSY: Mark 1:40-42 (NIV)

"Believing-prayer will heal you, and Jesus will put you on your feet. And if you've sinned, you'll be forgiven—healed inside and out." James 5:15 (MSG)

2. DELIVER THOSE WHO LOST THEIR FREEDOM.

"Jesus said 'The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." Luke 4:18-19 (NIV)

THE HEALING OF A PARALYZED MAN: Luke 5:18-25 (NIV)

"Christ has freed us so that we may enjoy the benefits of freedom. So be firm in this freedom, and don't become slaves again." Galatians 5:1 (GW)

3. FORGIVE THOSE WHO HAVE LOST THEIR DIGNITY.
