WHAT JESUS TAUGHT ABOUT YOUR FUTURE:

1. You Will LIVE FOREVER

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. - John 3:16 NIV

Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice and come forth—those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation.

2. The Future is MORE REAL THAN NOW

<u>SECURE</u> Your Destiny

• <u>SET YOUR MINDS ON</u> Your Destiny

Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. - Colossians 3:1-2 NIV

Walk the Talk A Small Group Guide

Read: Colossians 3:1-14

- 1. When buying clothes are you a name-brand buyer? A bargain hunter? Does quality or style matter? Or could you care less!?
- 2. Why do you think it is so important to set one's mind and heart on "things above" in the future? How is Christ our "life" in practical everyday terms a centering of our vision on that future?
- 3. Why does our awareness of a coming judgment (v. 6) become an incentive to "put to death" the old life we once lived and "put on the new self"?
- 4. Why is it important to live in a future where ethnic, economic, racial lines are no longer important (see v.11)? How does that future reality change the way we interact with each other on these issues here?
- 5. Pick out a piece of the spiritual garments we are called to "clothe" ourselves with in verses 12-13. Which one is the most important to you right now? Why?
- 6. How does our "life below" change, with the people we interact with on a day to day basis, when our "life above" directs our choices?
- 7. How can we as a group be bound together in perfect unity to a greater degree?
