1. If I Bring Him My Pain, He Shows Me Kindness

3. If I Wander Off from Him, He Brings Me Back

Jesus: "If a man has a hundred sheep, and one of them has gone astray, does he not leave the ninety-nine on the mountains and go in search of the one that went astray?"
