FIND THIS IN YOUR BIBLE: Ephesians 4:17-24

Four Spiritual Change-Agents

1. The Power of Epiphany

To put off your old self, which belongs to your former manner of life and is corrupt through deceitful desires. – Ephesians 4:22 (ESV)

Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices 10 and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator. – Colossians 3:9-10 (ESV)

THE GODLESS TAILSPIN OF LIFE WITHOUT GOD

Now this I say and testify in the Lord, that you must no longer walk as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their minds. ¹⁸ They are darkened in their understanding, alienated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, due to their hardness of heart. ¹⁹ They have become callous and have given themselves up to sensuality, greedy to practice every kind of impurity. – Ephesians 4:17-19 (ESV)

- A. THE **HARDNESS** OF THEIR HEART

- C. THE <u>RECKLESSNESS</u> OF THEIR CHOICES

2. The Potency of a New Creation

...to put on the new self, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness. – Ephesians 4:24 (ESV)

4. The Person of Jesus Christ

But that is not the way <u>you learned Christ</u>! — assuming that <u>you have</u> <u>heard [about] him</u> and <u>were taught in him</u>, as the truth is in Jesus, – Ephesians 4:20-21

- Ephesians 4:24 MORAL TRUTH
- Ephesians 4:25 HONEST TRUTH
