# What Christ's Death Points to

### 1. His Bones: the Passover Lamb



[31] Since it was the day of Preparation, and so that the bodies would not remain on the cross on the Sabbath (for that Sabbath was a high day), the Jews asked Pilate that their legs might be broken and that they might be taken away...

John 19:31-33, 36 ESV

...[32] So the soldiers came and broke the legs of the first, and of the other who had been crucified with him. [33] But when they came to Jesus and saw that he was already dead, they did not break his legs...

John 19:31-33, 36 ESV

...[36] For these things took place that the Scripture might be fulfilled: "Not one of his bones will be broken."

[29] The next day [John] saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!...[36] and he looked at Jesus as he walked by and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God!"

John 1:29,36 ESV

[21] Then Moses called all the elders of Israel and said to them, "Go and select lambs for yourselves according to your clans and kill the Passover 

...[43] And the LORD said to Moses and Aaron, "This is the statute of the Passover: no foreigner shall eat of it... ...[46] It shall be eaten in one house; you shall not take any of the flesh outside the house, and you shall not break any of its bones.

They shall leave none of it until the morning, nor break any of its bones; according to all the statute for the Passover they shall keep it.

[19] Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the LORD delivers him out of them all. [20] He keeps all his bones; not one of them is broken.

### 2. His Pierced Side: the Opened Fountain



[34] But one of the soldiers pierced his side with a spear, and at once there came out blood and water...

### [37] And again another Scripture says, "They will look on him whom they have pierced."

"And I will pour out on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem a spirit of grace and pleas for mercy...

...so that, when they look on me, on him whom they have pierced, they shall mourn for him, as one mourns for an only child, and weep bitterly over him, as one weeps over a firstborn.

Zechariah 12:10 ESV

On that day there shall be a fountain opened for the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, to cleanse them from sin and uncleanness.

Then he brought me back to the door of the temple, and behold, water was issuing from below the threshold of the temple toward the east (for the temple faced east)...

...The water was flowing down from below the south end of the threshold of the temple, south of the altar.

[37] On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink...

...[38] He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water."...

...[39] But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

Look at my hands and my feet and see who I am! Touch me and find out for yourselves. Ghosts don't have flesh and bones as you see I have."

[6] Water and blood came out from the side of Jesus Christ. It wasn't just water, but water and blood. The Spirit tells about this, because the Spirit is truthful...

...[7] In fact, there are three who tell about it. [8] They are the Spirit, the water, and the blood, and they all agree.

[1] Many false prophets have already gone out into the world, [2] and you can know which ones come from God. His Spirit says that Jesus Christ had a truly human body.
