Reigniting Romance

1. CULTIVATE <u>HEALTHY ATTITUDES</u>

For everything God created is good, and nothing is to be rejected, but all is to be received with a prayer of thanks. - 1 Timothy 4:4 (GN)

Honor marriage, and guard the sacredness of sexual intimacy between wife and husband. - Hebrews 13:4 (MSG)

Be happy, yes rejoice in your wife... Let her ... tender embrace satisfy you. Let her love alone fill you with delight. - Proverbs 5:18-19 (LB)

Use every part of your body to glorify God. - 1 Corinthians 6:20 (LB)

2. COMMUNICATE HONEST FEELINGS

Reliable communication permits progress. - Proverbs 13:17 (LB)

Encourage each other and build each other up. - 1 Thessalonians 5:11 (NLT)

3. CREATE HELPFUL ADJUSTMENTS

The marriage bed must be a place of mutuality -- the husband seeking to satisfy his wife, the wife seeking to satisfy her husband. Marriage is not a place to 'stand up for your rights.' Marriage is a decision to serve the other, whether in bed or out. - 1 Corinthians 7:3-5 (MSG)

You husbands must be careful of your wives, being thoughtful of their needs... - 1 Peter 3:7 (LB)

... You have made me eager for love... - Song of Solomon 6:12 (GN)

THE SONG OF ROMANTIC SEXUALITY

- Fragrances (1:12)
- Complimenting (1:15-16)
- Privacy (2:5)
- Affectionate touching (2:6)
- Attractive attire (4:9,11)
- Intimate talk (4:16)
- Unhurried time (5:1b)
- Special places (7:12)
- Total commitment (8:6-7)

Do not cheat each other of normal sexual relations, unless you both decide to abstain temporarily to make special time for prayer. But afterwards you should resume relations as before, or you will expose yourselves to the obvious temptations of Satan. – 1 Corinthians 7:7 (Phillips)
