GO DEEPER WITH THE LORD

Luke 5:5 (NLT) *Master, Simon replied, we worked hard all last night and didn't catch a thing. But if you say so, I'll let the nets down again. When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, Now go **out where it is deeper**, and let down your nets to catch some fish.*



TRUST IN THE LORD

Luke 5:6-9 (NKJV) *And when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was breaking. So they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink. When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord! Honor: high respect; great esteem, distinction, privilege, glory, tribute, credit, integrity, honesty, morality, righteousness, nobility, high-mindedness, right-mindedness, noble-mindedness;
