He was alone at the time because his disciples had gone into the village to buy some food. The woman was surprised, for Jews refuse to have anything to do with Samaritans. She said to Jesus, You are a Jew, and I am a Samaritan woman. Why are you asking me for a drink?*

# JESUS SAW HER SOUL AND NOT HER SKIN

**John 4:9-12**

*The woman was surprised, for Jews refuse to have anything to do with Samaritans. She said to Jesus, You are a Jew, and I am a Samaritan woman. Why are you asking me for a drink? Jesus replied, If you only knew the gift God has for you and who I am, you would ask me, and I would give you living water. But sir, you don't have a rope or a bucket, she said, and this is a very deep well. Where would you get this living water? And besides, are you greater than our ancestor Jacob who gave us this well? How can you offer better water than he and his sons and his cattle enjoyed?*

# ARE WE QUENCHING OUR THIRST WITH JESUS CHRIST?

**John 4:13-18**

*Jesus replied, People soon become thirsty again after drinking this water. But the water I give them takes away thirst altogether. It becomes a perpetual spring within them, giving them eternal life. Please, sir the woman said, give me some of that water! Then I'll never be thirsty again, and I won't have to come here to haul water.*

# BE PATIENT AS GOD WORKS ON OUR HEARTS

**John 4:16-18** ...*Go and get your husband, Jesus told her. I don't have a husband, the woman replied. Jesus said, You're right! You don't have a husband — for you have had five husbands, and you aren't even married to the man you're living with now.*

# JESUS WAS NOT SIDE-TRACKED BY HER DEFLECTION

**John 4:19-24** *The woman said to Him, Sir, I perceive that You are a prophet. Our fathers worshipped on this mountain, and you Jews say that in Jerusalem is the place where one ought to worship. Jesus said to her, Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you will neither on this mountain, nor in Jerusalem, worship the Father. You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship, for salvation is of the Jews. But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.*

# JESUS TOUCHED THE LIVES OF MANY BECAUSE HE TOUCHED THE LIFE OF ONE

**John 4:25-26** *The woman said, I know the Messiah will come — the one who is called Christ. When he comes, he will explain everything to us. Then Jesus told her, I am the Messiah.*
