**ENGLISH: “Ish-Bosheth” =
HEBREW: “eesh-bo'-sheth” =
“Man of Shame”**

2 Samuel 4:4
**ENGLISH: “Mephi-Bosheth” =
HEBREW: “mef-ee-bo'-sheth” =
“Dispeller of Shame”
FROM ROOT WORD MEANING
“to cleave in pieces”**
