# I. AT NAOMI'S URGING, RUTH COMMITTED HER BODY TO THE LIFE-GIVER

**Ruth 3:7** 

# HERE WE SEE ONE FAIRLY OBSCURE BIBLICAL CUSTOM:

Ruth 3:7 is one of the most puzzling verses in the entire Bible.

As such, it raises all sorts of interesting questions?

- -What is the origin of this strange custom?
- -Is this something Israelites are specifically commanded to undertake in the law?
- -Is it an Israelite custom or a Canaanite custom?
- -Or is it a wider Near-Eastern cultural custom?
- -Is this custom implicitly immoral?
- -Was Naomi right to direct Ruth to undertake this procedure?
- -Was Ruth right to undertake it regardless of Naomi's request or motives?
- -Why did this custom exist?
- -What purpose did it serve?

Ruth 3:7 is one of the most puzzling verses in the entire Bible.

What are the possible interpretations?

# THREE POSSIBLE INTERPRETATIONS FOR RUTH 3:7:

1. That Naomi was wrong in suggesting that Ruth bypass the rightful Kinsman-Redeemer of Elimalech's family and seduce Boaz while he was drunk, all for financial security.

After all, Ruth was a Moabitess; and this is exactly how "Moab" was conceived by Lot's older daughter in Genesis 19!

## THREE POSSIBLE INTERPRETATIONS FOR RUTH 3:7:

2. That Naomi was wrong in suggesting that Ruth embrace a non-Biblical (perhaps even Canaanite) custom of prostituting herself to Boaz so he would fulfill the role of Levirate Marriage/Kinsman-Redeemer of Elimalech's family and provide for them.

After all, this was what Tamar had done to Judah in Genesis 38 after his son Onan had refused to fulfill the duty of Levirate Marriage.

# THREE POSSIBLE INTERPRETATIONS FOR RUTH 3:7:

3. That Naomi was right in suggesting that Ruth simply seek the protection of the benefactor Boaz and beseech him to fulfill the role of Kinsman-Redeemer of Elimalech's family and provide for them.

IF NUMBER THREE
IS THE CASE, THEN,
IN EFFECT, RUTH IS
ACTUALLY PROPOSING
MARRIAGE TO BOAZ!

## SO WHICH ONE OF THE THREE POSSIBLE INTERPRETATIONS FOR RUTH 3:7 IS THE CORRECT ONE?

FIRST, REMEMBER THAT
THERE WERE MANY CUSTOMS
IN THAT DAY AND AGE WHICH
MAY SEEM ODD TO US NOW
BUT WERE PEFECTLY NORMAL
AND ACCEPTABLE IN THAT
TIME AND PLACE.

## EXAMPLES OF RATHER OBSCURE BIBLICAL CUSTOMS:

Mourning and Lamentation, Rending of Garments, Wearing of Sackcloth and Ashes, Anointing with Oil, Foot Washing, Greeting with a Kiss, Arranged Marriages, Blessings and Cursings, Swearing of Oaths (by Placing One's Hand under the Thigh), Betrothals, Dowerys, Trading Sandals, Consulting of Urim and Thummim, Cleromancy (Casting of Lots), Necromancy (Consulting the Dead), etc...

SECOND, REMEMBER THAT THE KEY TO INTERPRETING ANY DIFFICULT PASSAGE OF SCRIPTURE IS TO "PUT THE TEXT IN ITS CONTEXT"

Two "Contextual Reasons" why Number Three is the preferred interpretation:

- 1. RUTH 2:12 Gives Us the Specific Context
- 2. EZEKIEL 16:8 gives Us the General Context

THUS, I BELIEVE THAT
THE IMMEDIATE CONTEXT
SHOWS US THAT RUTH
WAS NOT MOTIVATED BY
PROSTITUTION, AS SOME
HAVE SUGGESTED, BUT
BY PROTECTION!

In addition to Judges 19
(the rape of the Levite's concubine) being the setting for the actual book, Ruth 2:9, 2:15, 2:16, 2:22, and 3:9 all show us the terrible danger that young attractive Ruth and even aged Naomi faced!

MORE TO THE POINT, THIS
INTERPRETATION IS SUPPORTED
BY THE GENERAL CONTEXT OF
GOD'S RELATIONSHIP WITH ISRAEL,
WHICH THE RELATIONSHIP OF
BOAZ AND RUTH SYMBOLIZE!
