A. First, We See Ruth Being Satisfied

B. Then, We See Ruth Being <u>Secured</u> As she got up to glean, Boaz gave orders to his men, "Even if she gathers among the sheaves, <u>don't</u> <u>embarrass her</u>. Rather, pull out some stalks for her from the bundles and leave them for her to pick up, and <u>don't rebuke her</u>." <u>Ruth 2:15-16</u>
