CONTEXT = RUTH 1:1a: "In the days when the judges ruled..."

THE BOOK OF RUTH AS A "PERICOPE": "a section within a section" From Greek: "peri" (around) and "kopé" (a cutting)

(aaa [bbb] ccc)

THE NARRATIVE OF ISRAELITE JUDGES INCLUDES THE PERICOPY OF RUTH:

(JUDGES [RUTH] 1 SAMUEL)

CONTEXT = RUTH 1:1a: "In the days when the judges ruled..."
