- **Heaven is seen as the place where God _____**

¹ This is what the LORD says: "Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool."
 Isaiah 66:1a (NIV)

➤ **Immediate Heaven:**

- **The place where God's people dwell with Him following _____ while awaiting their _____ resurrection**
