Doesn't she light a lamp, sweep the house and search carefully until she finds it? ${ }^{9}$ And when she finds it, she calls her friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost coin. ${ }^{10}$ In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents."
