a. Openly – wisdom is not hidden, but it has been revealed. i. Wisdom, "in the streets" calls aloud. ii. "In the open square" she lifts her voice. iii. "In the chief concourses (top of the walls) she cries out. iv. "At the entrance of the gates" in the city she peaks! v. Claiming ignorance is not an option. – Romans 1 b – How Long! c – You simple ones! i. The simple are the open minded and naïve. This is one of the target groups of Proverbs 1:4 ii. All are encouraged to turn, but specifically the simple ones are being encouraged to turn. Before they become mockers and fools. d – Turn at my rebuke. i. Rebuke is the noun form of the verb which means to decide, judge or rebuke. ii. Discussion question: What happens to the naïve person the longer he or she stays naïve? 1.
