Genre Specific Principles

NARRATIVE PRINCIPLES

- 1 Narratives are stories, written to recount how individual people, in real-life scenarios, have followed the truth of God.
- 2 Narratives do not *teach* doctrine but they *illustrate it*.
- 3 Narrative interpretation is guided by a recognition of the “scenes” of a story. Identifying the boundaries of a scene, the main point of each scene, and the flow of thought between scenes is how we best determine principle meaning.
