Genre Specific Principles

NARRATIVE PRINCIPLES

- Narratives are stories, written to recount how individual people, in reallife scenarios, have followed the truth of God.
- Narratives do not teach doctrine but they illustrate it.
- Narrative interpretation is guided by a recognition of the "scenes" of a story. Identifying the boundaries of a scene, the main point of each scene, and the flow of thought between scenes is how we best determine principle meaning.
