# GENESIS 15 (ABRAHAMIC COVENANT)

“the word of the Lord came”

- ◆ “Fear not, Abram, I am your shield; your reward shall be very great.”
- ◆ “This man shall not be your heir; your very own son shall be your heir.”
- ◆ “Look toward heaven, and number the stars, if you are able to number them. So shall your offspring be.”

## GENESIS 15 (ABRAHAMIC COVENANT)

“how am I to know that I shall possess it?”

- ◆ “Bring me a heifer three years old, a female goat”
- ◆ “And he brought him all these, cut them in half, and laid each half over against the other.”
- ◆ “Know for certain that your offspring will be sojourners in a land that is not theirs....servants....afflicted for four hundred years”
- ◆ “But I will bring judgment on the nation that they serve”

## GENESIS 22 (ABRAHAMIC COVENANT\*)

“God tested Abraham...”

- ◆ “Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you.”
- ◆ “God will provide for himself the lamb for a burnt offering, my son.”
- ◆ Abraham called the name of that place, “The Lord will provide”; as it is said to this day, “On the mount of the Lord it shall be provided.”

## **EXODUS 19:5-8 (MOSAIC COVENANT)**

<sup>5</sup> Now therefore, if you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession among all peoples, for all the earth is mine; <sup>6</sup> and you shall be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.’ These are the words that you shall speak to the people of Israel.” <sup>7</sup> So Moses came and called the elders of the people and set before them all these words that the Lord had commanded him. <sup>8</sup> All the people answered together and said, “All that the Lord has spoken we will do.” And Moses reported the words of the people to the Lord.

# MOSAIC COVENANT

---

**Parties**     Yahweh and Israel

**Terms**     If Israel obeys the Law, then God blesses them

**Nature**     Conditional

**Outcome**     Israel would remain in their “treasured” status relationally with God. They would be unique to all other nations as God’s ambassadors *TO* other nations.

## EXODUS 12 (MOSAIC COVENANT\*)

“It is the Lord’s passover...”

- ◆ “your lamb shall be without blemish, a male”
- ◆ “take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and the lintel of the houses”
- ◆ “I will pass through the land of Egypt...and I will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt...the blood [on the houses] shall be a sign for you... And when I see the blood, I will pass over you,”

## EXODUS 12 (MOSAIC COVENANT\*)

“It is the Lord’s passover...”

- ◆ “This day shall be for you a memorial day, and you shall keep it as a feast to the Lord; throughout your generations, as a statute forever...”
- ◆ “It is the sacrifice of the Lord’s Passover, for he passed over the houses of the people of Israel in Egypt...”

## DEUTERONOMY 33:10-11 (MOSAIC COVENANT\*)

<sup>10</sup> They shall **teach** Jacob your rules and Israel your law; they shall put **incense** before you and whole **burnt offerings** on your altar.

<sup>11</sup> Bless, O Lord, his substance, and accept the work of his hands; crush the loins of his adversaries, of those who hate him, that they rise not again.”

## **DEUTERONOMY 30:11-20 (MOSAIC COVENANT\*)**

<sup>11</sup> “For this commandment that I command you today is not too hard for you, neither is it far off. <sup>12</sup> It is not in heaven, that you should say, ‘Who will ascend to heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?’ <sup>13</sup> Neither is it beyond the sea, that you should say, ‘Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?’ <sup>14</sup> But the word is very near you. It is in your mouth and in your heart, so that you can do it.



## **DEUTERONOMY 30:11-20 (MOSAIC COVENANT\*)**

<sup>15</sup> “See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil.

<sup>16</sup> If you obey the commandments of the Lord your God that I command you today, by loving the Lord your God, by walking in his ways, and by keeping his commandments and his statutes and his rules, then you shall live and multiply, and the Lord your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it.

<sup>17</sup> But if your heart turns away, and you will not hear, but are drawn away to worship other gods and serve them, <sup>18</sup> I declare to you today, that you shall surely perish. You shall not live long in the land that you are going over the Jordan to enter and possess.

<sup>19</sup> I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Therefore choose life, that you and your offspring may live, <sup>20</sup> loving the Lord your God, obeying his voice and holding fast to him, for he is your life and length of days, that you may dwell in the land that the Lord swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them.”

- ◆ “the Lord will make you a house.”
- ◆ “I will raise up your offspring...establish his kingdom...forever.”
- ◆ “Your throne shall be established forever.”

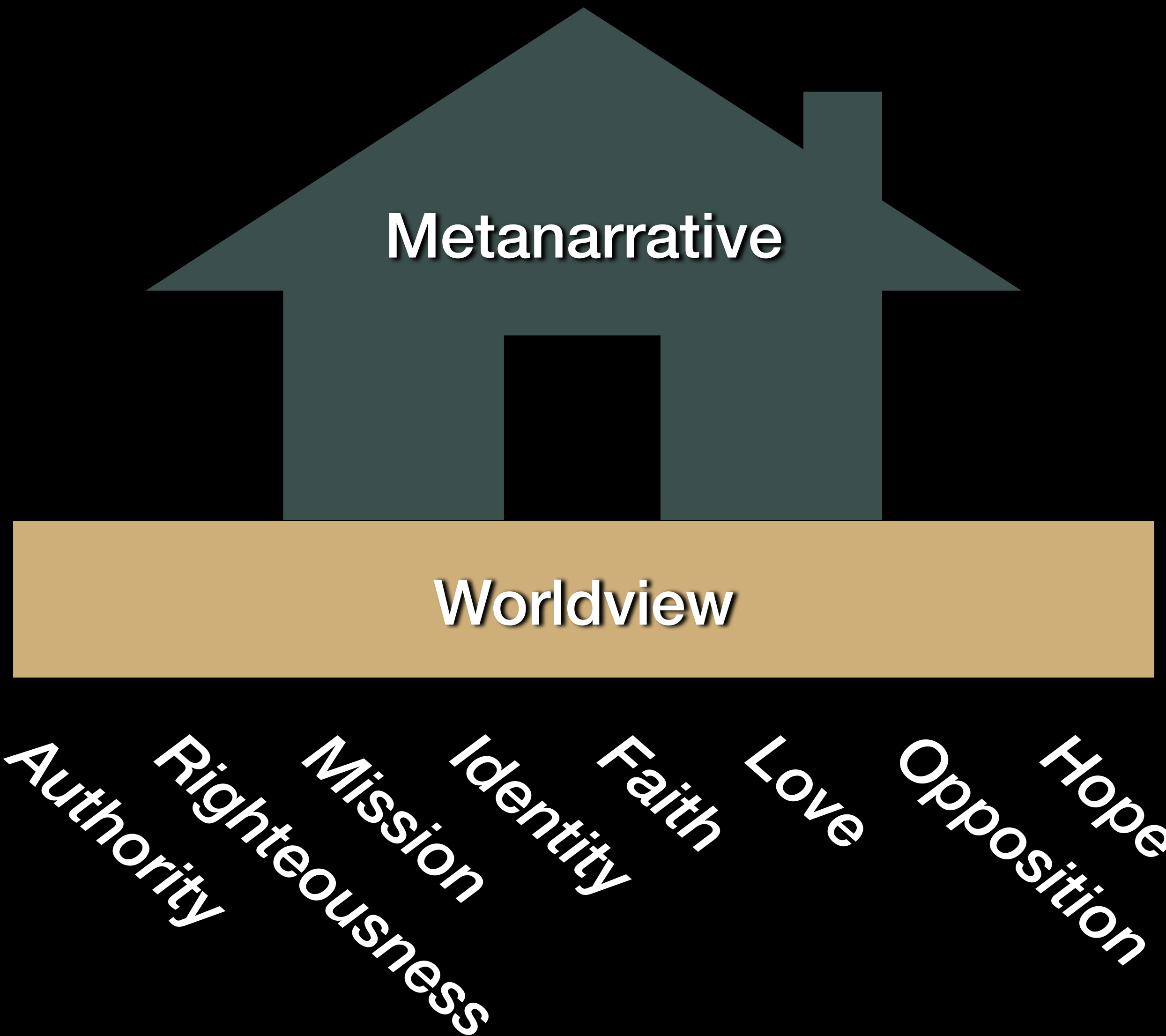
