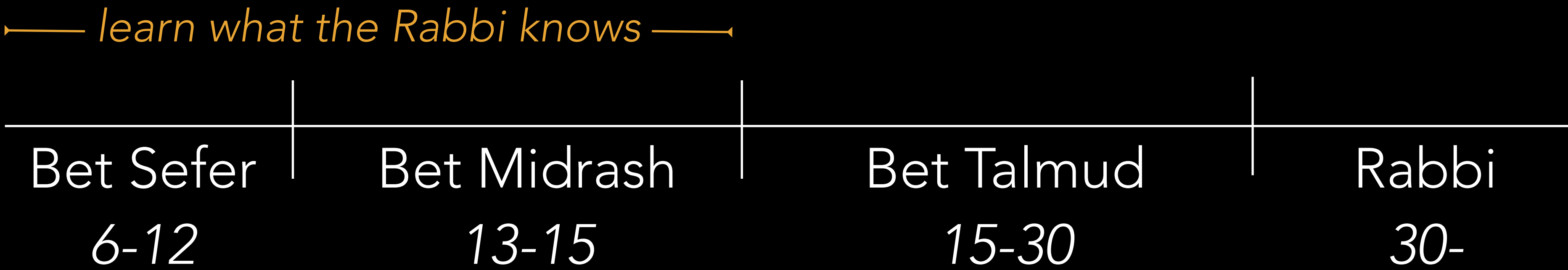
DISCIPLE

- *talmidim*: a pupil in the school of a Rabbi

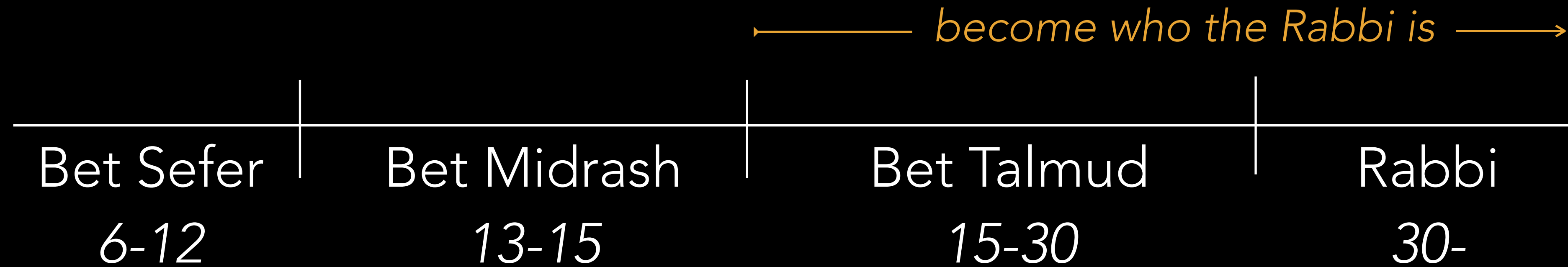

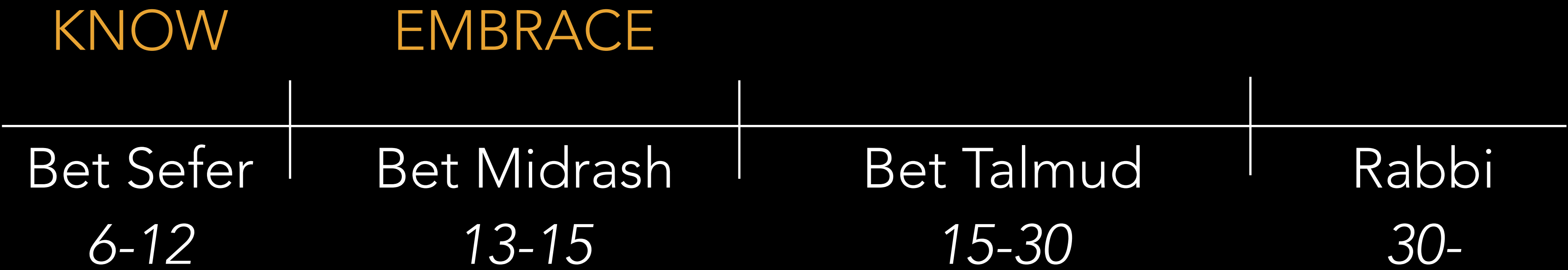

METHOD

Modeling

- 1 If discipleship is in real life, then disciples need to see the goal lived out in real life before them.

Speaking

- 2 If discipleship is through learning, then disciples need someone to teach them truth for real life.

Prayer

- 3 If discipleship is unto Jesus, then disciples need faithful and faith-filled prayer for their journey.

PLAN

Informal

- 1 Disciples need friendship and normal life interaction in the contexts where truth is supposed to be lived out.

Formal

- 2 Disciples need intentional input; spiritual guidance for how to react to life's challenges and how proactively live with God.

Biblically Rooted

- 3 Disciples need to build conviction and practice in the Bible as the foundation for their entire life (good, bad, formal, informal).

EVALUATION

Self

- 1 Disciplemakers need to evaluate their own walk with God, humbly acknowledging their own need for growth.

Disciple

- 2 Disciples need to be lovingly helped in the process of learning how to humbly acknowledge the need for growth.

Process

- 3 Disciplemakers need to constantly balance contentment with process and the willingness to consider better paths forward.

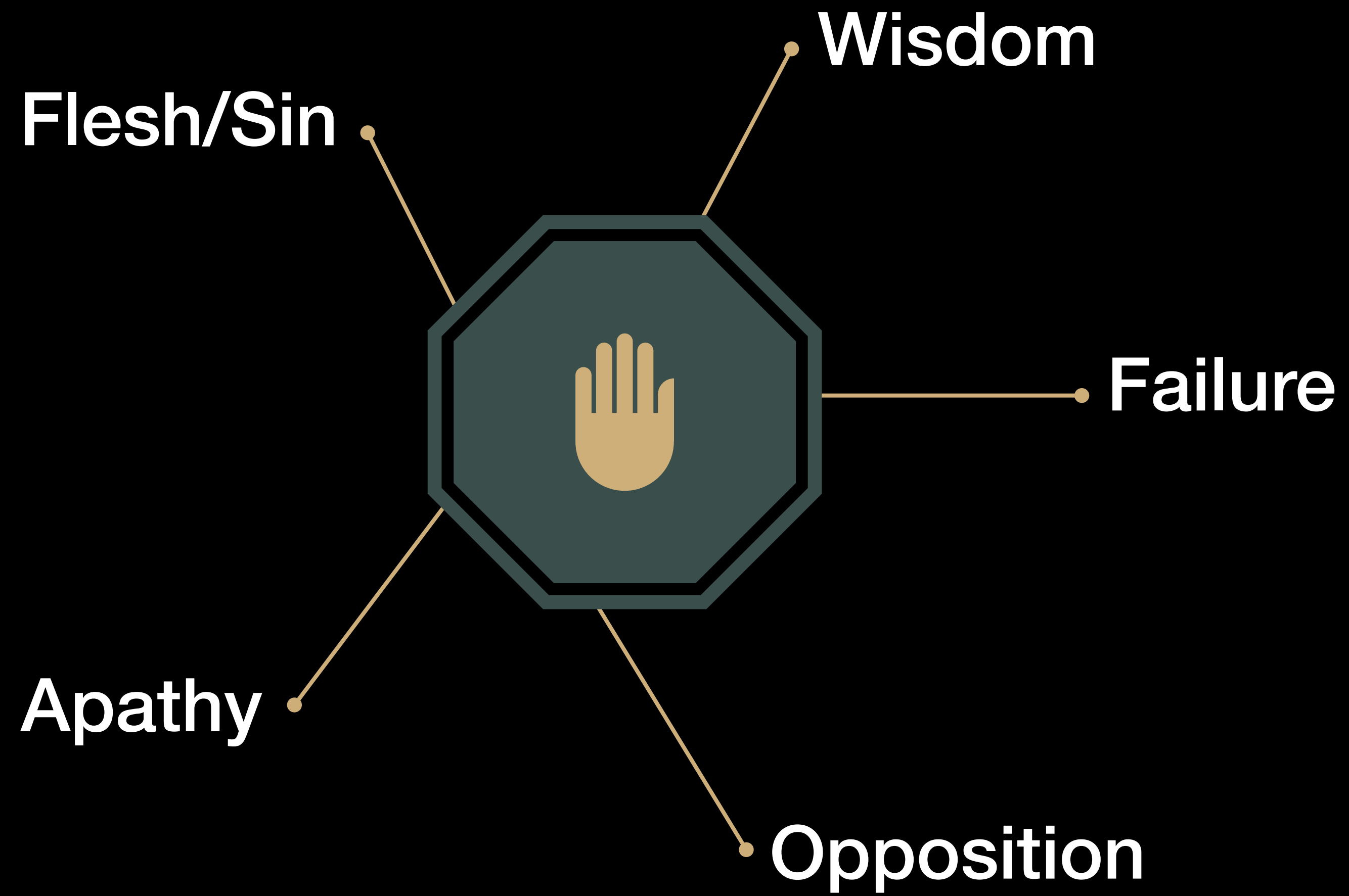
