**Sent** - Jesus was sent by the Father. He adopted the view of a sent one in every aspect of his life. *(John 5:36-37)*

**Live** - Jesus' life fully embraced his identity as one sent by the Father to do the Father's mission. *(John 4:31-24; 5:19)*

**Invite** - Jesus invited others to enter into his life and join in the mission he was engaged in. The invitation gave vision and means. *(Mt 4:19)*

**Equip** - Jesus equipped those whom he invited unto the mission. *(Mt 5-7; Mt 8:25; Mt 10; Mt 14:13-20; Mt 16:13-20)*
