PASSAGES

Matthew 28:18-20; John 15:1, 4-5; Matthew 4:1; Acts 1:1-2; Matthew 12:28; Matthew 26:36-46; 1 Peter 2:21-23; John 1:16-17; Romans 12:1-2

PREPARE (MC LEADER)

- 1. Before leading your group into studying the passages, take some time to study and pray through the passages yourself.
- 2. Consider these questions as you engage with the passages that you will discuss with your MC.
 - What do these passages tell me about God's plan for His people?
 - What do these passages tell me about how Jesus interacted with the Father?
 - What do these passage tell me about how Jesus lived in the Holy Spirit?
 - What do these passages tell me about what Jesus is offering to people?
 - What do these passages tell me about how I am to live as a child of God?
 - What do these passages confront in my thinking and the ideology of the world system?
 - Consider how this paradigm for making disciples ("Making disciples involves me helping others accept more and more the Grace and Truth that Jesus offers and live more effectively in the place where Jesus lived") compares with your current understanding of making disciples. What are some of the similarities and differences?

DISCUSS (GROUP)

- 1. Review the core principle(s) from the study.
- 2. Elicit initial questions or comments about the central teaching.
- 3. Consider these discussion questions to help your MC engage with the main principle(s):
 - How are the Grace and Truth that Jesus offers different than what the world offers?
 - What challenges make it difficult to accept the Grace and Truth that Jesus offers?
 - What are some challenges that make it difficult to see yourself as part of the Trinity?
 - How is submitting to the Father's will and moving forward in the power of the Holy Spirit different than "obeying the rules?"

APPLY (GROUP)

- 1. Share your own personal reflections/convictions/struggles related to accepting the Grace and Truth that Jesus offers and choosing to live where Jesus lived (submitting to the Father's will and moving forward in the guidance and power of His Spirit).
- 2. Lead others into recognizing their personal struggles with accepting the Grace and Truth that Jesus offers and choosing to live where Jesus lived.
- 3. Discuss action steps as individuals or as an MC that might aid in accepting more and more the Grace and Truth that Jesus offers and choosing to live where Jesus lived.

John 15 - ABIDE


Abiding is accepting what Jesus offers as Creator, Savior, Sustainer, and King, to the point of entrusting my mind, will, and emotions to Him




Matthew 26 - Jesus Example




