POSTURE

John 6:38

John 5:30

WORK

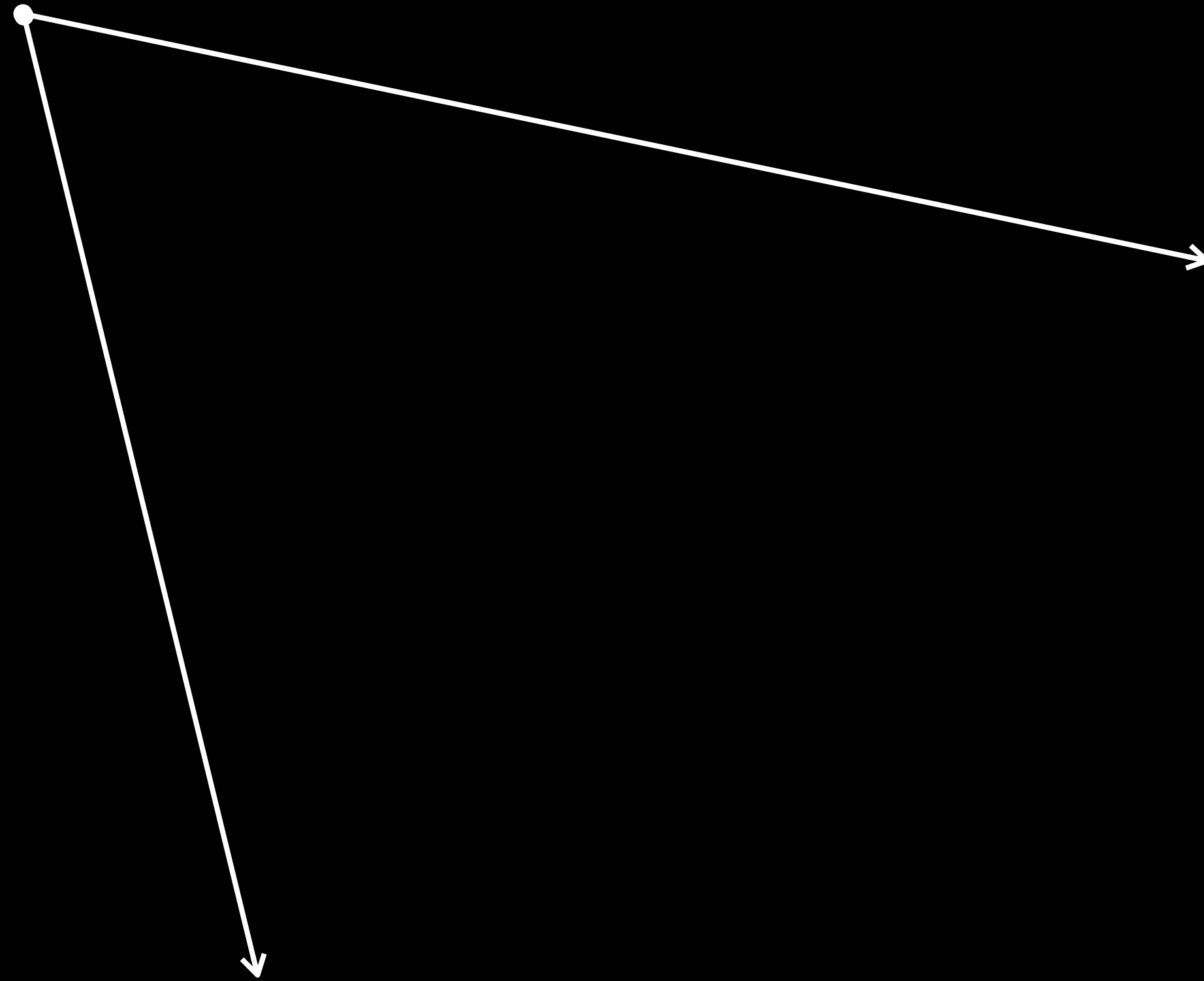
John 4:34

WORK



Intentional

Purposeful and planned encounters with relational history and accountability.

Incidental

Unplanned encounters with less relational context and minimal accountability.

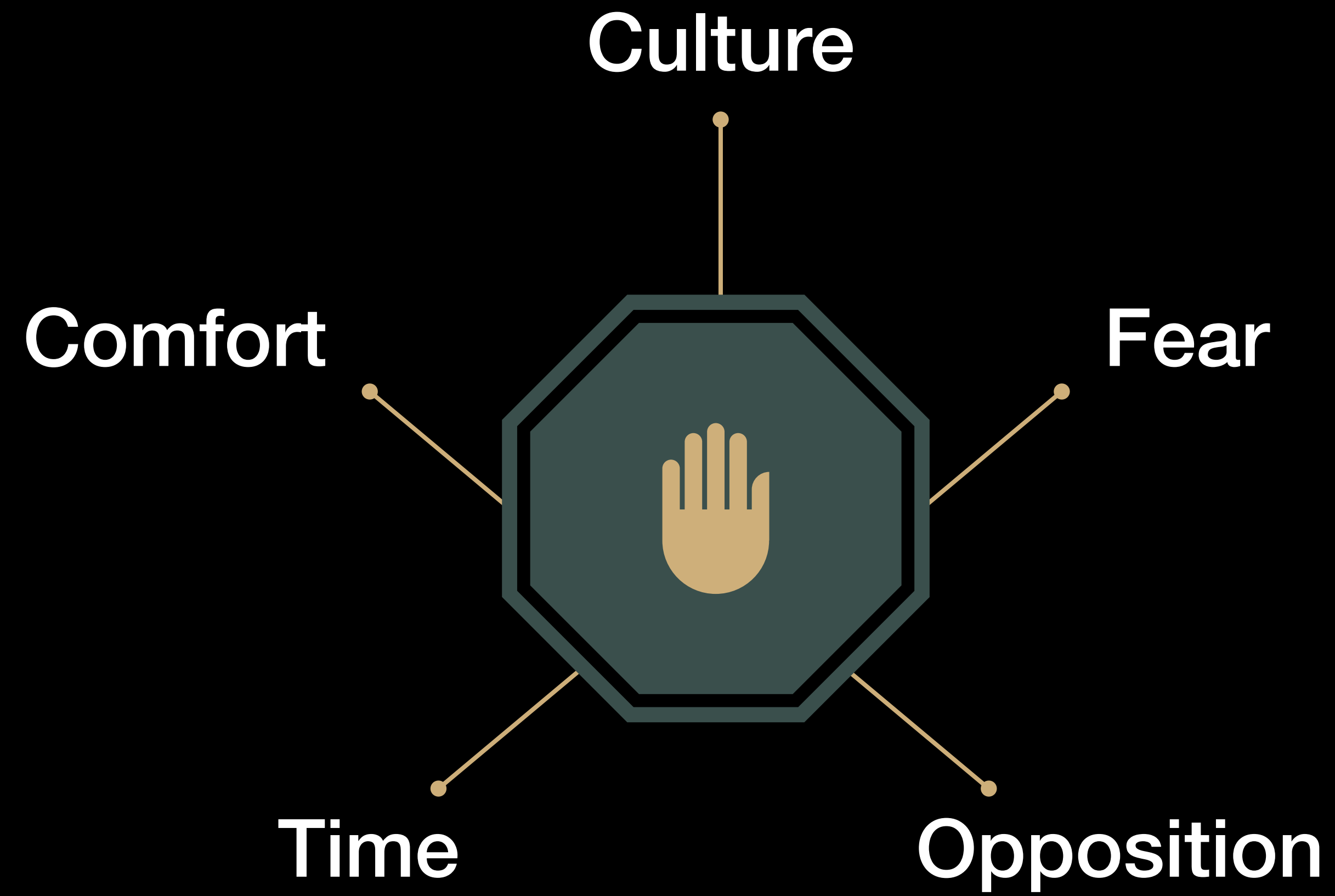
