Genre Specific Principles



PRINCIPLES

- 1** Wisdom literature is concerned with making sense of life and how to live well. It includes advice for navigating conflict, perspective, and loss.
- 2** They tell us how God patiently deals with us in our different moods and musings at life; providing a pattern to life that helps us live wisely in spite of confusion and suffering.
- 3** In the Old Testament, Proverbs deals with generalizations, Job shows a practical application, and Ecclesiastes captures the search for meaning in the midst of life.
- 4** In the New Testament, only James provides wisdom literature, although it is in more succinct ways than the Old Testament.
