PRINCIPLES APOCALYPTIC

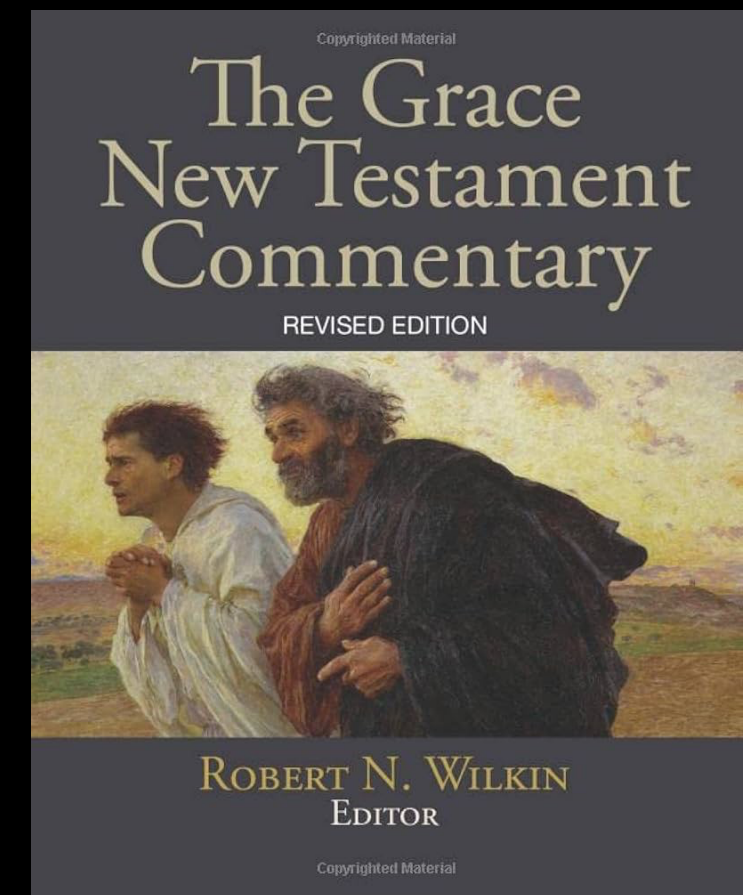
- 1 Remember the audience and setting.

- 6 Benefit from others.



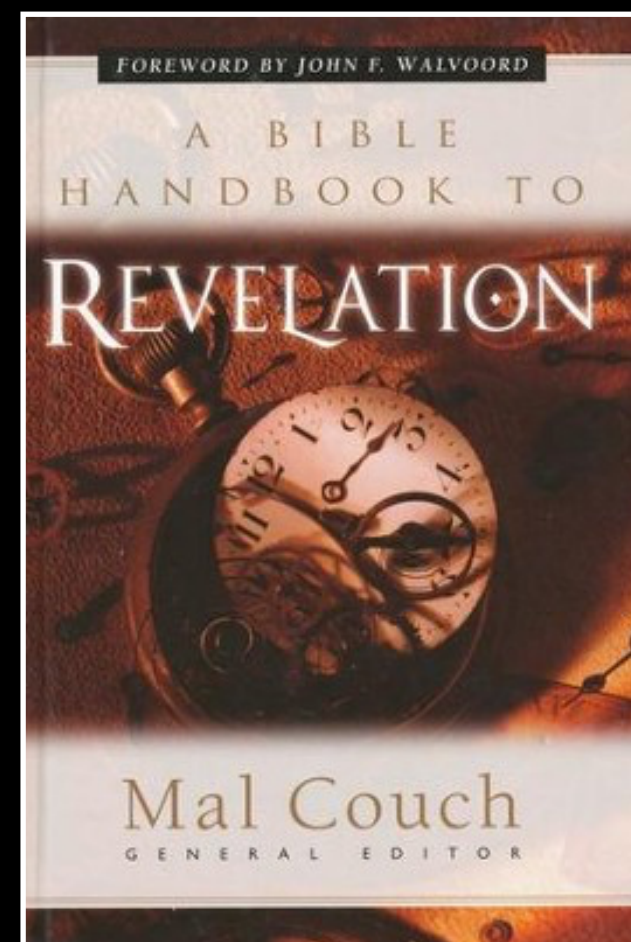

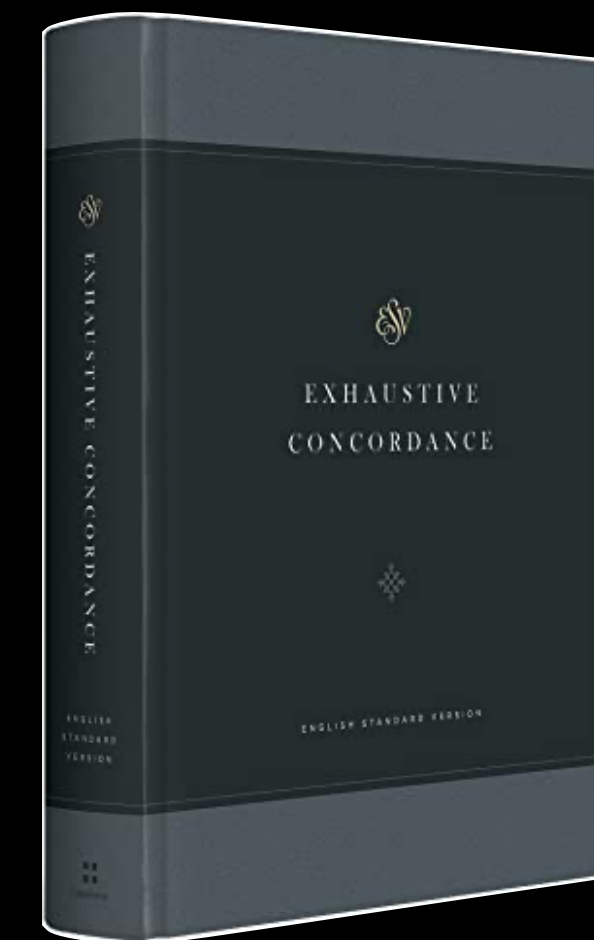
