



RELATE PRINCIPLES

- Bible interpretation requires a personal connection with God, *during* the process, if we are to truly interpret and apply the truth that is sourced in God.
- Our mental, spiritual, and relational orientation to God is crucial to our study process. We must be aimed at relational growth with God or else our process is simply an exercise in knowledge acquisition.

RELATE STEPS

- 1 Turn off phones, smartwatches, etc
- Talk with God, focus on listening to Him
- Focus your mind on the purpose of your study

OBSERVE PRINCIPLES

- It is important to approach a passage with ease, initially focusing on getting oneself "into" the text.
- 2 Faithful interpretation is built on a simple and thorough initial observation of the passage.
- Organizing and understanding the details and flow of a passage are impossible without knowing what the details are.
- Developing a questioning and inquisitive mind about a passage is essential in continuing the more difficult work of interpreting the passage.

OBSERVE STEPS

- 1 Relate
- Read: the section of study, two times (ESV & NLT), from start to finish, uninterrupted. Listen to an audio recording of the section.
- Questions: write down any questions and observations that you have. (Consider adding a "community element" to this process)
- Summary: Write a one sentence summary of each paragraph/minisection and one for the entire chapter.
