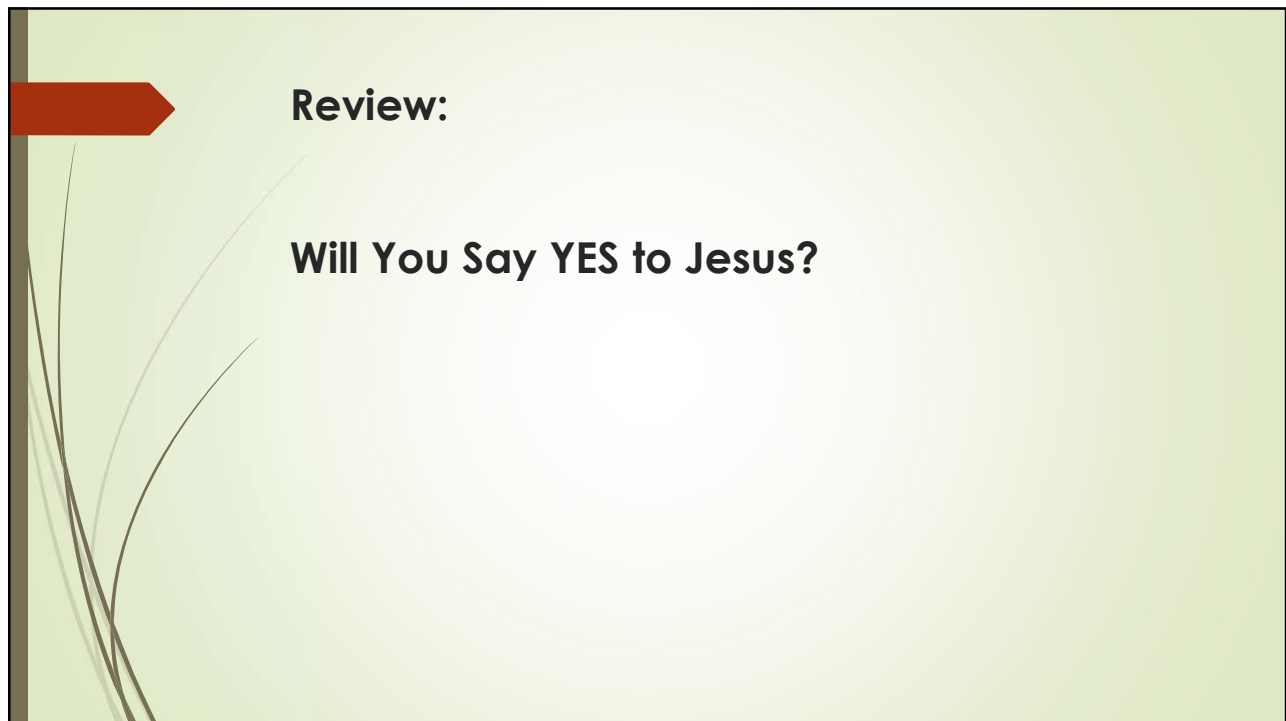

- **HF Calling:** to bring redemption, restoration, and reformation to individuals, families, leaders, and ministries in the power and freedom of Jesus Christ; equipping them to advance God's Kingdom in the world.
- **Mission and calling remain constant; expression changes over time**

The Believer's Missional Life

- **We are no longer our own — we live on assignment (1 Cor. 6:20)**
- **We continue the ministry Jesus started**
- **The question remains: Will you say YES to Jesus and His call?**

Matthew 7:1–6

- 1 “Do not judge, or you too will be judged.
- 2 For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.
- 3 “Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in your brother’s eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye?
- 4 How can you say to your brother, ‘Let me take the speck out of your eye,’ when all the time there is a plank in your own eye?
- 5 You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother’s eye.
- 6 “Do not give dogs what is sacred; do not throw your pearls to pigs. If you do, they may trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you to pieces.

Matthew 7:1–6 Overview

- Judged by the measure you use
- The speck and the plank
- Pearls before pigs
- One main idea: It starts with humility

Point 1: Judged by the Measure You Use

- Be careful by the standard you use on others
- Self-righteous judgment invites the same measure back
- There is no place for pride or superiority in the Kingdom of God
- God gives grace to the humble (1 Peter 5:5)

Clarifying Judgment

- Jesus is not forbidding discernment
- We are called to judge rightly and call out sin
- Order matters: humility before correction

Point 2: The Speck and the Plank

- 3 “Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in your brother’s eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye?”
- 4 How can you say to your brother, ‘Let me take the speck out of your eye,’ when all the time there is a plank in your own eye?

Point 2: The Speck and the Plank

- What Jesus Is Teaching
 - We see others’ sin more easily than our own
 - Self-examination comes before confrontation
 - Ignoring our own sin while correcting others is hypocrisy

The Required Posture

- ▀ **Before the Lord and Others**
 - ▀ **Humility**
 - ▀ **Repentance**
 - ▀ **Teachability**
- ▀ **Judgment produces blindness**
- ▀ **Humility produces clarity**

Looking for the Log in Our Own Eye

- ▀ **Personal responsibility before God**
- ▀ **It is easy to blame people, systems, or circumstances**
- ▀ **Our Buttons Reveal Our Issues**
 - ▀ **Anger**
 - ▀ **Impatience**
 - ▀ **Critical spirit**
 - ▀ **Defensiveness**

Our Church DNA

- A culture of humility and self-examination
- Living Free in Christ as our operating system
- A people committed to saying yes to Jesus
- A culture of being unoffendable

How God Reveals the Logs in Our Eyes

- God is gentle and patient
- He reveals obvious sins first
- Over time He reveals heart issues and attitudes
- If we allow Him, He continues refining us

Accelerating the Freedom Process

- Increase humility and self-responsibility
- Increase vulnerability and accountability
- Invite prophetic insight
- Engage in biblical discipleship (LSF)
- Commit to prayer and community

The Power of Repentance

- The enemy has access to where lies and agreements go
unchallenged!

Heart-Level Questions

- Am I willing to honestly assess myself?
- Do I walk in humility or pride?
- Am I open to others ministering to me?
- Will I pursue Jesus and His process this year?

Point 3: Pearls Before Pigs

- 6 “Do not give dogs what is sacred; do not throw your pearls to pigs. If you do, they may trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you to pieces.”

Point 3: Pearls Before Pigs

- Jesus teaches discernment
- Not everyone is ready to receive sacred truth
- Discernment knows when to speak and when to step back

Application: Our Response

- Will you say YES to Jesus?
- Will you posture your heart with humility?
- Will you ask: God, what are You teaching me about me?
- Will you go first and repent?

Conclusion

- **Correction is not forbidden — it is sequenced**
- **Humility → Repentance → Clarity → Loving Help**
- **Will you give yourself to God's process?**

Transaction

- **Ask God to reveal your own reactions and buttons**
- **Confess pride and sinful responses**
- **Invite God to keep teaching you about you**
