JESUS ON PRAYER – Pt. 8

Matthew 6:13

*CHURCH MISSION STATEMENT

*REVIEW

- We have addressed the *Our Father in heaven and hallowing His name, His kingdom come, and His will be done on earth as it is in heaven.*
- We then looked at the components of prayer related to living for God's kingdom's presence on earth and His will be done on earth.
- Jesus then instructs us that God has a vested interest in our physical well-being when we pray, *give us this day our daily bread.*
- Then Jesus directed us regarding forgiveness.
- The first half of Jesus' model prayer reminds us of how big and great God is, while the next section reminds us of how intimate and personal God is.
- Jesus addresses our needs of 1) *daily sustenance*, 2) *tranquility of soul*, and 3) *personal rescue from evil*.

SCRIPTURE

***Matthew 6:9–13** (NKJV) *In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. 10 Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven. 11 Give us this day our daily bread. 12 And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors. 13 And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.*

*INTRODUCTION

- We live in a world system that is evil and is under the direction and control of Satan.
- We also live as the prey of the Enemy of our souls, Satan, who roams around seeking those he can devour. **1 Peter 5:8**
- The next component to be included in our prayer, is protection and deliverance from temptation and the evil one.
- This prayer is deep, urgent, and intensely practical plea.
 - It is a prayer for spiritual protection and victory in the midst of a real war for our souls.
 - It acknowledges our own weakness and God's supreme power in the face of two formidable foes: 1) *our internal susceptibility* and 2) *the external enemy*.

*PROTECTION AGAINST THE EVIL ONE

Matthew 6:13 (NKJV) . . . But deliver us from the evil one

* **Meaning of “Deliver”:** Gk Wd: *rhysai* - pull out, save; be saved, be secure; save oneself; tear from; remove, withdraw ¹

- It’s the language of snatching someone from the very jaws of a predator.
- It carries the sense of timely urgency.

* **Reality of Evil One:** Greek phrase: *apo tou ponērou*, which can be translated either as “from evil” (abstract concept) or “from the evil one” (personal being).

- A strong case, supported by the immediate context of the New Testament, favors personal versus abstract interpretation.
- Scripture consistently personifies evil in the figure of Satan (see John 8:44 – your father the devil, Ephesians 6:16 – fiery darts of the wicked one, 1 John 5:19 – wicked one).
- *Jesus is not teaching us to pray for deliverance from a vague, impersonal force of misfortune, but from the intelligent, malicious will of our adversary, the devil.*
- This prayer is a recognition that we are engaged in a spiritual conflict against a cunning foe who seeks to destroy.

* **UNDERSTANDING BIBLICAL TRUTH ON SATAN**

- We must avoid the world’s two common errors: 1) either dismissing Satan as a myth or 2) granting him a power he does not possess.
- The Bible presents a clear and sobering picture of our adversary, Satan.
 - Understanding his nature, tactics, and—most importantly—his definitive status in relation to those who are in Christ is crucial.

* **The Person and Nature of Satan**

- Satan is not an impersonal force or a mere symbol of evil. Scripture reveals him as a created, personal, spiritual being of high intelligence and great power, though forever subordinate to the sovereign God.

* **His Origin**

- Satan was originally a magnificent angelic creation. **Ezekiel 28:12-15** (often interpreted typologically as referring to Satan behind the king of Tyre) describes him as “the signet of perfection, full of wisdom and perfect in beauty,” created blameless until “unrighteousness was found in you.”

* **Ezekiel 28:12–15** (NKJV) “Son of man, take up a lamentation for the king of Tyre, and say to him, ‘Thus says the Lord GOD: “You were the seal of perfection, Full of wisdom and perfect in beauty. 13 You were in Eden, the garden of God; Every precious stone was your covering: The sardius, topaz, and diamond, Beryl, onyx, and jasper, Sapphire, turquoise, and emerald with gold. The workmanship of your timbrels and pipes Was

prepared for you on the day you were created. *14 “You were the anointed cherub who covers; I established you; You were on the holy mountain of God; You walked back and forth in the midst of fiery stones. 15 You were perfect in your ways from the day you were created, Till iniquity was found in you.

*His Fall

- His fall is detailed in **Isaiah 14:12-14**, where pride and a desire to usurp God’s throne (“*I will make myself like the Most High*”) led to his corruption and judgment.
- He was not created evil but became evil by his own choice.
- Satan was then judged by God, and in judgment was forcibly expelled from heaven.

***Ezekiel 28:18** (NKJV) “You defiled your sanctuaries By the multitude of your iniquities, By the iniquity of your trading; Therefore I brought fire from your midst; It devoured you, And I turned you to ashes upon the earth In the sight of all who saw you.

- In **Luke 10:18**: Jesus says, “*I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven.*” This statement, made in the context of the disciples’ authority over demons when sent out by Jesus, indicates a definitive judgment against Satan’s power.
- There is a more detailed account of this event in Revelation.

***Revelation 12:7–9** (NKJV) And war broke out in heaven: Michael and his angels fought with the dragon; and the dragon and his angels fought, 8 but they did not prevail, nor was a place found for them in heaven any longer. 9 So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

- Adam was created and given dominion over the earth. Guess who that included.
- Lucifer, through deception in spiritual warfare, wrestled from Adam that spiritual authority and dominion.
- Consequently, he is currently regarded as the ruler of this world. (2 Cor. 4:4)
- This is the current context for life, a spiritual battleground, a spiritual battlefield with evil and wickedness resulting in ruin and death prevailing.

*His Character and Names

(His names reveal his character)

- ***Satan**: Meaning “adversary” or “accuser” (Zechariah 3:1, Revelation 12:10). He stands against God and His people.
- **Devil**: From the Greek diabolos, meaning “slanderer” or “false accuser.”
- **The Evil One**: (Matthew 13:19, 1 John 5:19). His fundamental nature is moral corruption.
- **The god of this World/Age**: (2 Corinthians 4:4). He exerts a powerful influence over the systems and philosophies of the fallen world, blinding unbelievers to the truth.
- **The Prince of the Power of the Air**: (Ephesians 2:2). He commands a hierarchy of demonic forces (Ephesians 6:12).
- **A Liar and the Father of Lies**: (John 8:44). Deception is his primary weapon.

- **A Roaring Lion**: (1 Peter 5:8). He is predatory, seeking to devour and destroy.

***His Power and Limitations**

- ***Satan** is powerful, but his power is derivative and limited.
- He is a creature, not the Creator.
- He is subject to God's ultimate authority, as seen in the story of Job (Job 1:12, 2:6).
- His power is real over the unbelieving world (1 John 5:19).
- His power is limited against Christians (Luke 10:19; Eph. 2:6; Col. 2:15)

***Satan's Status and the Born-Again Christian**

***The Believer's Position**

- Translated from Satan's Dominion.
- The most critical truth is that a born-again Christian has been fundamentally transferred from Satan's kingdom into Christ's kingdom.

***Colossians 1:13** (NKJV) *He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love,*

***Ephesians 2:5–6** (NKJV) *even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), 6 and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,*

- The Father “has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son.”
- We are no longer citizens of Satan's domain; we are redeemed subjects of the King of Kings.

***The Believer's Authority**

- Christ won a definitive, public victory over Satan and his forces.
- Colossians 2:15 states that God “disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him.”

***James 4:7** (NKJV) *Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.*

- The believers' authority over Satan is not based on their own spiritual prowess but in their union with Christ, who has already defeated him.
- We fight from a position of victory, not for victory.

***Spiritual Conflict**

- Despite Satan's defeat, the war continues until Christ's return.
- Ephesians 6:12 makes it clear we still wrestle “against the spiritual forces of evil.”

- ***Temptation**: He appeals to our flesh (James 1:14).
- **Accusation**: He attempts to bring charges against us before God and fill our minds with condemnation, seeking to make us ineffective (Revelation 12:10, Zechariah 3:1).
- **Deception**: He spreads false doctrine and leads people astray (2 Corinthians 11:3, 1 Timothy 4:1).
- **Obstruction**: He attempts to obstruct God's work (1 Thessalonians 2:18).
- **Oppression**: He can bring intense external pressure, persecution, and suffering upon believers (as seen in Job and the martyrs in Revelation).

***APPLICATION**

1. **Do Not Fear Him, But Respect His Tactics.**
 - We are not to live in terror of Satan, but we must be sober-minded and vigilant against his schemes (1 Peter 5:8).
 - Ignorance is not spirituality.
2. **Live in the Whole Armor of God.** – Ephesians 6:10-18
 - Our defense is proactive, not passive.
 - We are to daily clothe ourselves in the spiritual reality of truth, righteousness, the gospel, faith, salvation, the Word of God, and prayer (Ephesians 6:10-18).
3. **Pray – God Deliver Us from the Evil One**
4. **STAND UP TO HIM!!** – In truth, obedience, authority of Christ, and prayer!
 - The command is clear: "Resist the devil, and he will flee from you" (James 4:7).
 - We resist not in our own name but in the authority of Jesus Christ.
 - We resist by submitting to God, standing firm in faith (1 Peter 5:9), and using the Word of God as our weapon, and exercising Christ's authority just as Jesus did (Matthew 4:1-11).

In Summary:

- Satan is a powerful, intelligent, and malicious created being who is the sworn enemy of God and His people.
- However, for the born-again Christian, he is a *defeated* enemy.
 - Our calling is to live in the reality of Christ's victory,
 - resisting the devil's schemes through faith and obedience,
 - confident that the God who saved us will also deliver us from every evil attack.
