STAY ALERT



Matthew 7:15-20 (NKJV) "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thornbushes or figs from thistles? Even so, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a bad tree bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Therefore, by their fruits you will know them."

Beware: “be in a state of alert, be concerned about, be on one’s guard”

προσέχω - “proseco” -

- *Present* → *Now !*
- *Active* → *Not passive !*
- *Imperative* → *A Command !*

Beware: “be in a state of alert, be concerned about, be on one’s guard”

We are commanded to:

- *always actively* be in a state of alert,
- *always actively* be concerned about,
- *always actively* be on one’s guard

Matthew 7:15 – “Beware of *false prophets*...”

“Prophets” – religious people who lead

Includes:

- ✓ people with a title and those without a title
- ✓ people who demonstrate leadership/ initiative

Matthew 7:15 – “Beware of *false prophets*...”

- Matthew 16:1-3: “And the Pharisees and Sadducees came ...they asked him to show them a sign ...He answered them, “When it is evening, you say, ‘It will be fair weather, for the sky is red.’ And in the morning, ‘It will be stormy today, for the sky is red and threatening.’ You know how to interpret the appearance of the sky, but you cannot interpret the signs of the times.”
- Num 12:1-2: Then Miriam and Aaron spoke against Moses ... they said, “Has the LORD indeed spoken only through Moses? Has He not spoken through us also?...”

Matthew 7:15 – “Beware *of false prophets...*”

- *Jesus’ warning was for all time... “For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect...” (Matthew 24:23-25)*
- *Paul to Timothy: “For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching, but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own passions, and will turn away from listening to the truth and wander off into myths.” (2 Timothy 2:2-4)*

Matthew 7:15b – “...who come to you in sheep’s *clothing...*”

- “Looks Good”:
 - *Outward* appearance is attractive
 - Gen 3:6: “...the woman saw that the tree was good... that it was pleasant to the eyes...”

Matthew 7:15b – “...who come to you in sheep’s *clothing*...”

- “Sounds Good”
 - *Similar* to the real thing
 - Flattery is dangerous – not the same as encouragement

THE DISGUISE (cont.)



Matthew 7:15b – “...who come to you in sheep’s *clothing*...”

- Words and Content can be “sheep’s clothing” and hide the inner reality
 - 1 Co 4:19–20: Apostle Paul: “... I will find out *not the talk* of these arrogant people but their power. For the kingdom of God does *not consist in talk but in power*.”
 - Luke 19:10: [Jesus]: “for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save [Gr. *SOZO*] that which was lost.”

Matthew 7:15b – “... *but inwardly* they are ravenous wolves.”

Inner motivation is the issue - self-centered vs. submitted to Jesus as Lord.

James 3:16: “For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there will be disorder and every evil thing.”

Matthew 7:15b – “...*but inwardly* they are ravenous wolves.”

- Jealousy – Matthew 27:18: [Jesus] “...He knew that they had handed Him over because of envy.”
- Selfish ambition - Philippians 2:3: “Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves.”

“selfish ambition” is not about having goals; it’s about **advancing yourself** at the expense of others, driven by ego, status, or rivalry – it’s self at the center.”

Matthew 7:15b – "...but inwardly they are **ravenous** wolves."

"ravenous": marked by greed and cruelty; have strong jaws, sharp fangs; behave with fiendish cunning; mercilessly attack, seize, and kill their prey

1 Peter 5:8-9a: "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a **roaring lion**, **seeking** whom he may **devour**."

Matthew 7:15b – "...but inwardly they are **ravenous** wolves."

Wolves are pack animals – so too are false leaders - grow like a cancer - **they seek to form a group, gather associates and followers**; alone they are weak and more vulnerable, so their goal is to form a group, a coalition, even a mob. Such people desire to attack you as "we want, we think, we believe, we need..."

[See Numbers 16 - Korah, Dathan and Abiram]

THE EVIDENCE

Matt 7:16-18: “You will recognize them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thorn bushes, or figs from thistles? So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit. A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit.”

Fact: a good tree cannot bear bad fruit; a bad tree cannot bear good fruit.

Promise repeated : “...you will recognize them by their fruits (v20)

THE EVIDENCE (cont.)

*Jesus curses a fig tree: “outward appearance good,” **but has no fruit**:*

Mark 11:12-14: “...Seeing in the distance a fig tree in leaf, He went to find out if it had any fruit. When He reached it, **he found nothing but leaves**... Then He said to the tree, ‘May no one ever eat fruit from you again.’”

*Note: Fruit normally comes **first** on a fig tree. In early spring, fig trees form tiny figs on the bare branches **before the leaves fully unfold**. Then the leaves follow shortly after. A fig tree with only leaves looks good “on the outside” – but with no fruit, it is useless...*

THE EVIDENCE (cont.)

Jesus' warning is still relevant today - examples:

- *"Heaven and hell are myths."*
- *"The God of love will not permit anyone to be punished everlastingly." (False "grace")*
- *"Satan is a myth – demons are not real"*
- *The miracles in the Bible are just poetic illustrations*
- *The gifts of the Spirit listed in the bible no longer exist*
- *"Sin is just a mental problem. It has nothing to do with guilt. Get rid of your guilt-complex."*
- *"People are not responsible for their so-called sins. The blame, if any, rests on parents or on society."*
- *"Everyone has their own truth. My truth does not need to be your truth" ("situation ethics")*

THE CONSEQUENCES

For the false Leaders:

Matthew 7:19: "Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire."

John 15:6: "If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned."

THE CONSEQUENCES (cont.)

For deceived Followers (wolves are “ravenous”)

- **Damaged**
- **Defeated**
- **Discouraged**
- **Distrusting** (of any leaders)

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APPLICATION



1. Monitor your own inner peace

Colossians 3:15: “And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful.”

Never ignore your own inner concerns or “lack of peace”

Never say to yourself or others, “It must just be me...”

Hint: Wolves don’t “smell” the same as Sheep – Carnivores vs. Herbivores



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APPLICATION



2. Humble Yourself

1 Peter 5:6: Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you

Philippians 2: 5-9: Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.”

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APPLICATION



3. Test everything in the context of Scripture – in Context

*Hebrews 4:12: “For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a **discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.**”*

Deuteronomy 4:2; 12:32: [Moses] “You shall not add to the word that I command you, nor take from it...Everything that I command you, you shall be careful to do. you shall not add to it or take from it.”

See also Revelation 22:18–19

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APPLICATION

4. Beware: *alert to what is not seen* with natural senses

1 Peter 5:8-9a: "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. *Resist* him, steadfast in the faith

Our battle is "not against flesh and blood" (Ephesians 6:10+)

The enemy is not passive – maintain a mindset to stay alert.



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APPLICATION

5. Take note of the "fruit" - and listen with discernment

Galatians 5:22-23a: "...the fruit of the Spirit is love*, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control..."

* biblical "agape" love; not "Hallmark movie" emotional affection

Luke 6:45: "A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart brings forth evil. For *out of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks.*"



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APPLICATION



6. *Pray - for insight and discernment*

*Philippians 1:9–10 – [Apostle Paul]: “And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge **and all discernment**, that you may approve the things that are excellent...”*

Pray to understand the difference between:

*Right and Wrong → Right and **Almost Right***
