Start Talking:

Read 2 Corinthians 10:3-5. Discuss some of the strongholds that can be pulled down by our mighty weapons. Specifically, what are our weapons?

Pastor Bobby said, "Pastors who compete, deplete their vision. They're miserable." Besides against the devil, is there a place for competition within Christianity? Yet, why do many Christians continually compete against each other?

Pastor Bobby said, "Church is not golf. It's baseball. When one wins, we all win." What drives isolation between churches?

Re-read 2 Corinthians 10:3-5. Think about today's culture. What are some of the arguments, reasonings, theories and proud things that set themselves up against the true knowledge of God? Be specific. Are they becoming more emboldened and visible?

Start Thinking

When Peter contradicted Jesus, Jesus didn't even speak to him. He said, "Get thee behind me Satan." Have you ever shot arrows of anger at someone who loves you but was unintentionally doing the work of Satan-spouse, child, or friend? Where does personal responsibility stop and being influenced by Satan begin? After all, God punished Adam and Eve after Eve was influenced by the devil. Discuss.

Why is it is difficult for many Christians to identify that, when we oppose each other, that this is a ploy from the devil? Is it sometimes difficult to remember that we are at war against an invisible enemy, so we blame a visible one? Discuss.

Start Sharing:

Do you think that competition within the churches has helped the cause and witness of Christ more than harmed it? Share.

Are there some philosophies in today's world that you are tempted to embrace, although they are contrary to God's Word? What are they? Have you observed some Christians defending ideas that are not from God?

In what ways are Christians being thrown into the lions' den today? How are certain practices of our culture being intolerant towards Christians?

Start Praying:

"Lord, open our eyes to see who the real enemy is, and to resist having any camaraderie with him. Wake us up to the fact that this life is not supposed to be paradise, but it is a war zone. And encourage us by the truth that we have already won, and are more than conquerors."
