Deuteronomy 6:6-7 **CSB**

⁶These words that I am giving you today are to be in your heart.

⁷Repeat them to your children. Talk about them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.

Deuteronomy 6:6-7 **NIV**

⁶These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts.

⁷ **Impress** them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.

Deuteronomy 6:6-7 **ESV**

⁶ And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart.

⁷ **You shall teach them diligently** to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.

Principle 3: Equip them with the Word of God.

IMPRESS

“שָׁנַן” (shanán): “impress”

- means “to sharpen.”
 - a precise, intentional, and repeated process of teaching God’s commandments.

Key Steps to Disciple Others: Deuteronomy 6:6-7:

1. Store God’s Word in Your Heart.

Matthew 23:27-28 CSB

²⁷ “Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! You are like whitewashed tombs, which appear beautiful on the outside, but inside are full of the bones of the dead and every kind of impurity. ²⁸ In the same way, on the outside you seem righteous to

people, but inside you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness.

3 things to do:

- First, Memorize God's Word.

Psalm 119:11 CSB

I have treasured your word in my heart so that I may not sin against you.

- Second, Meditate on God's Word.

Psalm 1:2 CSB

Instead, his delight is in the Lord's instruction, and he meditates on it day and night.

- Third, Apply God's Word.

James 1:22 CSB

But be doers of the word and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

2. Repeat and Talk About Scripture.

"These words that I am giving you today are to be in your heart. Repeat them to your children. Talk about them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up."

Repetition:

- Reinforcement of Knowledge.
- Muscle Memory and Skill Acquisition.

Conversations:

- Active Engagement.

Integrate God's Word into Daily Life.

It's the parent's role to create environments where the worship of God and the Word of God are commonplace and central to the home.
