Mark 4:20 CSB

²⁰ And those like seed sown on good ground hear the word, welcome it, and produce fruit thirty, sixty, and a hundred times what was sown."

John 15:5

I am the vine; you are the branches. <u>The one who remains in me and I in him produces much fruit</u>, because you can do nothing without me.

Ephesians 2:8-9

Point 1: Measure for success.

Mark 4:24

And he said to them, "Pay attention to what you hear. By the measure you use, it will be measured to you—and more will be added to you.

Measure - value, interest, and priority.

God's Word is powerful and will produce amazing results if you allow it to.

Acts 17:11-12 CSB

¹¹ The people here were of more noble character than those in Thessalonica, since <u>they received the word with eagerness and examined the Scriptures daily</u> to see if these things were so. ¹² Consequently, many of them believed, including a number of the prominent Greek women as well as men.

Upon hearing the Word, they did 2 things.

- 1. Received it with eagerness.
- 2. Examined it every day.

Let the Word of God transform what you think about your life, opinions, limitations, etc.

Romans 12:1-2

Therefore, brothers and sisters, in view of the mercies of God, I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your true worship. 2 Do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may discern what is the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God.

Point 2: Is your ground (soul) ready for God's word?

Mark 4:14

The sower sows the word.

4 Soil Conditions: (Mark 4:3-8)

- 1. The path.
- 2. The rocky soil
- 3. The thorny soil
- 4. The good soil

The goal is to hunger for God, maintain openness, and actively seek His guidance, maximizing life for His glory.

Strive to be a 100-fold Christian:

- 1. Evaluate the Word of God.
- 2. Reflect daily.
- 3. Acknowledge that the Word of God has transformative power.
