THE 11th Hour – Part 1 THE RETURN OF CHRIST

13 Brothers, we do not want you to be ignorant about those who fall asleep, or to grieve like the rest of men, who have no hope. 14 We believe that Jesus died and rose again and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him. 15 According to the Lord's own word, we tell you that we who are still alive, who are left till the coming of the Lord, will certainly not precede those who have fallen asleep. 16 For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. 17 After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever. 18 Therefore encourage each other with these words. (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18)

Three reasons we as Christians have hope.

1. The Return: Christ is Coming Again

And if I go and prepare a place for you, <u>I will come back</u> and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am. John 14:3

We believe that Jesus died and rose again and so we believe that <u>God will bring with</u> Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him. (1 Thessalonians 4:14)

16 For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the <u>dead in Christ will rise</u> first. (1 Thessalonians 4:16)

There are two resurrections:

- 1. For Christians who are raised from the dead
- 2. For those who are not Christians

6 Blessed and holy are those who have part in the <u>first resurrection</u>. The <u>second death</u> has no power over them... Revelation 20:6

Second death: You can be born once and die twice, or you can be born twice and die once.

2. The Rapture: Living Christians are taken away

17 After that, we who are still alive and are left will be <u>caught up</u> together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air... (1 Thessalonians 4:17)

Caught up = to seize, to catch, rescued, take away to safety.

...That is how it will be at the coming of the Son of Man. 40 Two men will be in the field; one will be taken and the other left. 41 Two women will be grinding with a hand mill; one will be taken and the other left... 44 So you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect him. (Matt 24:39-41, 44)

Behold, I come like a thief! Blessed is he who stays awake and keeps his <u>clothes with</u> <u>him</u>, so that he may not go <u>naked and be shamefully exposed</u>. (Revelation 16:15)

3. The Reunion: Christians will be with God Forever

17 After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever. 18 Therefore encourage each other with these words. (1 Thessalonians 4:17-18)

51 Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed—52 in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. 53 For the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality... 54b then the saying that is written will come true: "Death has been swallowed up in victory." 55 "Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?"... 57 But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. 58 Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain. (1 Corinthians 15:51-55, 57-58)
