2. Be LOYAL to your COVENANTS and COMMITMENTS.

God's Promise: God's FAVOR and a GOOD REPUTATION.

...Then you will win favor and a good name in the sight of God and man.

3. Rely on God's <u>WISDOM</u> and God's <u>WAYS</u>.

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him...

God's Promise: He will <u>PROTECT</u> us and <u>DIRECT</u> us all of our lives.

...and he will make your paths straight.

4. Be <u>HUMBLE</u> about <u>YOURSELF</u> and toward <u>OTHERS</u>.

Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord and shun evil...

God's Promise: A <u>HEALTHY SELF IMAGE</u> leads to a healthy you.

This will bring health to your body and nourishment to your bones.

5. Choose to be <u>GENEROUS</u> recognizing that all you have is a <u>GIFT</u> from <u>GOD</u>.

Honor the Lord with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops...

God's Promise: I will meet all of your <u>NEEDS</u> and <u>PROVIDE</u> for you.
