1 Chronicles 20:5

In another battle with the Philistines, <u>Elhanan son of Jair</u> killed **Lahmi** the brother of Goliath the Gittite, who had a spear with a shaft like a weaver's rod.

Gob = the pit or the place of the snare

Lahmi = "the eater" (The Big appetite)

TEMPTATION IS ANYTHING THAT PROMISES <u>SATISFACTION</u> AT THE COST OF <u>OBEDIENCE</u> TO GOD.

FOUR TRUTHS ABOUT TEMPTATION

1) IT'S NOT A <u>SIN</u> TO BE <u>TEMPTED</u>.

For we do not have a high priest [Jesus] who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been <u>tempted in every way</u>, just as we are <u>yet he did not sin</u>. Hebrews 4:15

2) YOU ARE NEVER <u>ABOVE</u> TEMPTATION.

So, if you think you are <u>standing firm</u>, <u>be careful that you don't fall</u>! 1 Corinthians 10:12

3) GOD WILL <u>NEVER</u> TEMPT YOU.

And remember, when you are being tempted, do not say, "<u>God is tempting</u> <u>me</u>." God is never tempted to do wrong, and <u>he never tempts anyone else</u>. ¹⁴ Temptation comes from our <u>own desires</u>, which entice us and drag us away. ¹⁵ These desires give birth to sinful actions. And when sin is allowed to grow, it gives birth to death. James 1:13-15 NLT

4) THERE IS <u>ALWAYS</u> A WAY <u>OUT</u>.
