## Scene 1: When It Looks Like Evil Is Winning *Acts 12:1-5*

James is killed.

Peter is arrested.

The church prays.

**Remember:** Just because it looks like the enemy is winning doesn't mean the King has lost control.

### Scriptures

- Isaiah 55:8-9
- Romans 8:28

### Key Truth

## Scene 2: The King Is Still Working *Acts 12:6-11*

Peter sleeps.

God moves.

Peter doesn't even realize it.

**Remember:** God is often working before we recognize it. God's presence is greater than our problems.

### Scriptures

- Romans 8:18
- Philippians 1:21
- Isaiah 26:3

### Key Truth

Biblical peace is not the absence of problems, It is confidence in God's \_\_\_\_\_.

Where might God be working that I have failed to recognize?

### Scene 3: The King Hears His People *Acts 12:12-17*

The church prays.

God answers.

The church is surprised.

**Remember:** Don't put God in a box. Don't answer prayers before God does.

#### Scriptures

- Ephesians 3:20
- Hebrews 4:16

#### Key Truth

Don't let \_\_\_\_\_ determine the size of your prayers.

Let God determine the size of your prayers.

### Scene 4: The King Will Not Share His Throne *Acts 12:20-24*
